1/4 yard	Folio - Butter (E)	7755-03
1/4 yard	Folio - Peach (F)	7755-22
1/4 yard	Folio - Orange (G)	7755-36
1/4 yard	Folio - Light Pink (H)	7755-25
1/8 yard	Foliage - Sky (I)	2654-17
1/8 yard	Dragonflies - Violet (J)	2652-55
1/8 yard	Fuchsia Flowers - Pastel (K)	2653-10
1 3/8 yards	Medallion - Pastel (L)	2650-10
5/8 yard	Foliage - Royal (M)	2654-77*
3 1/2 yards	Dragonflies - Violet (Backing)	2652-55

### Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Gossamer Garden Panel - Pastel (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 22 1/2" x 41 1/2" rectangle, centered on the panel.

#### From the Folio - Off White (B), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x 25 1/2" WOF strips.
- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 60 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 43 1/2" strips.
- (2) 2" x 41 1/2" WOF strips.
- (8) 1 1/2" x WOF strips.

#### From the Dragonflies - Royal (C), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip.

#### From the Butterflies - Cream (D), cut:

- (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6 1/2" squares.
- (5) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (42) 4 1/2" squares.

#### From the Folio - Butter (E), cut:

- (2) 1 1/2" x WOF strips.

#### From the Folio - Peach (F), cut:

- (2) 1 1/2" x WOF strips.

#### From the Folio - Orange (G), cut:

- (2) 1 1/2" x WOF strips.

#### From the Folio - Light Pink (H), cut:

- (2) 1 1/2" x WOF strips.

#### From the Foliage - Sky (I), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip.

#### From the Dragonflies - Violet (J), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip.

#### From the Fuchsia Flowers - Pastel (K), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip.

#### From the Medallion - Pastel (L), cut:

- (4) 6 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 6 1/2" x 63 1/2" strips.
- (3) 6 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 6 1/2" x 43 1/2" strips.

#### From the Foliage - Royal (M), cut:

- (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Dragonflies - Violet (Backing), cut:

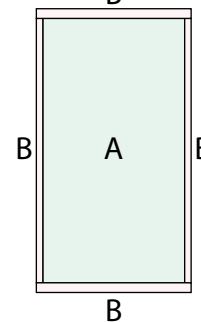
- (2) 63" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 63" x 83" back.

### Block Assembly

1. Sew (1) 2" x 41 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the 22 1/2" x 41 1/2" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 25 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).

Trim the block to measure 24 1/2" x 44 1/2".

Trim block to measure 24 1/2" x 44 1/2" AFTER adding Fabric B borders

2. Sew together (1) 1 1/2" x WOF Fabric E strip, (1) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric B strip and (1) 1 1/2" x WOF Fabric F strip, lengthwise and in that order from left to right, to make (1) Strip Set 1 (Fig. 2). Repeat to make a second Strip Set 1.

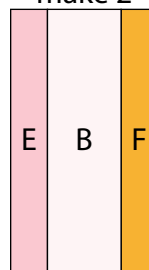

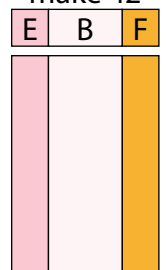

3. Cut the (2) Strip Set 1's into (42) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" Unit 1 strips (Fig. 3).

4. Repeat Steps 2-3 and refer to Figures 4-5 for fabric identification and location to make (42) Unit 2 strips.

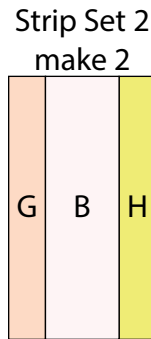

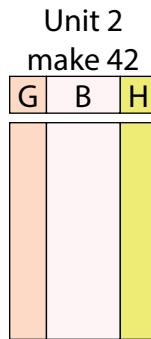

5. Repeat Steps 2-3 and refer to Figures 6-13 for fabric identification and location to make (11) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Unit 3 strips, (12) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Unit 4 strips, (10) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Unit 5 strips and (9) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Unit 6 strips.

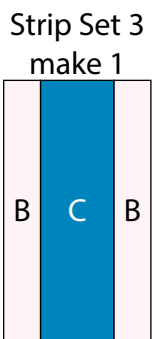

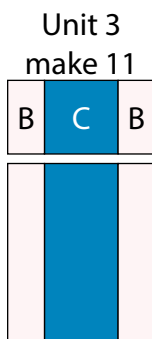

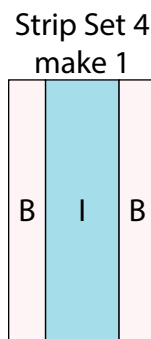

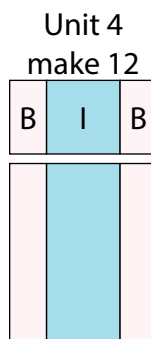

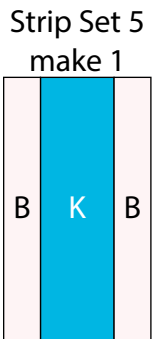

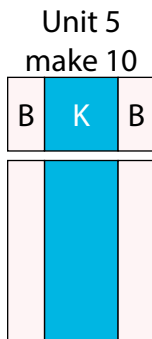

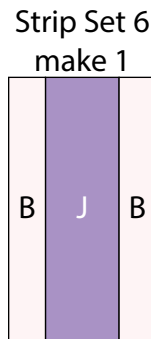

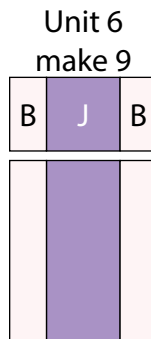

6. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to the top of (1) Unit 3 strip. Sew (1) Unit 2 strip to the bottom of the Unit 3 strip to make (1) Unit 7 square (Fig. 14). Repeat to make (11) Unit 7 squares total.

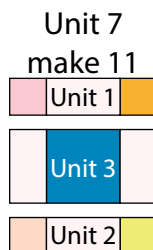

7. Repeat Step 6 and refer to Figures 15-17 for component identification, location and orientation to make (12) Unit 8 squares, (10) Unit 9 squares and (9) Unit 10 squares.

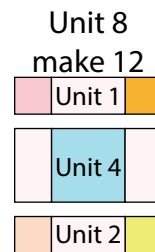

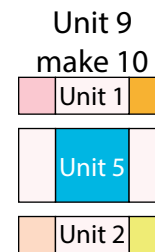

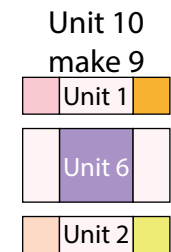

8. Follow Figure 18 and sew together (11) assorted unit squares and (11) 4 1/2" Fabric D squares into a 2 x 11 matrix to make the Left Side Border.

9. Follow Figure 19 and sew together (11) assorted unit squares and (11) 4 1/2" Fabric D squares into a 2 x 11 matrix to make the Right Side Border.

10. Follow Figure 20 and sew together (10) assorted unit squares and (10) 4 1/2" Fabric D squares into a 2 x 10 matrix to make the Top Border.

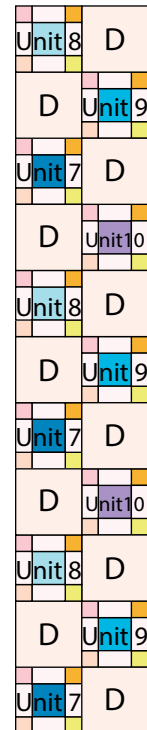

Right Side Border

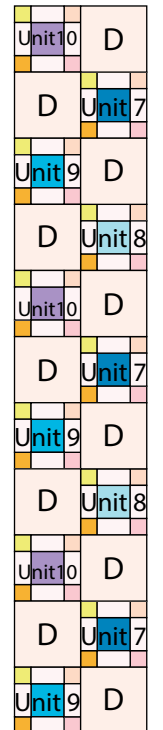

Top Border

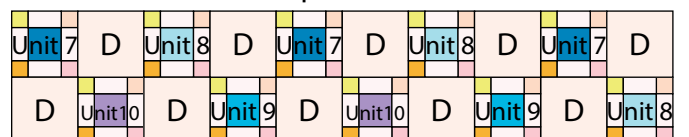

11. Follow Figure 21 and sew together (10) assorted unit squares and (10) 4 1/2" Fabric D squares into a 2 x 10 matrix to make the Bottom Border.

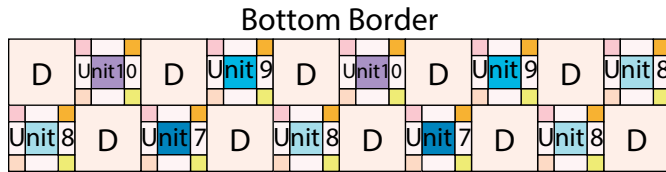

### Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the *Quilt Layout* while assembling the quilt top. The arrows in the *Quilt Layout* represent the fabric print direction.)

12. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right of the Center Block. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

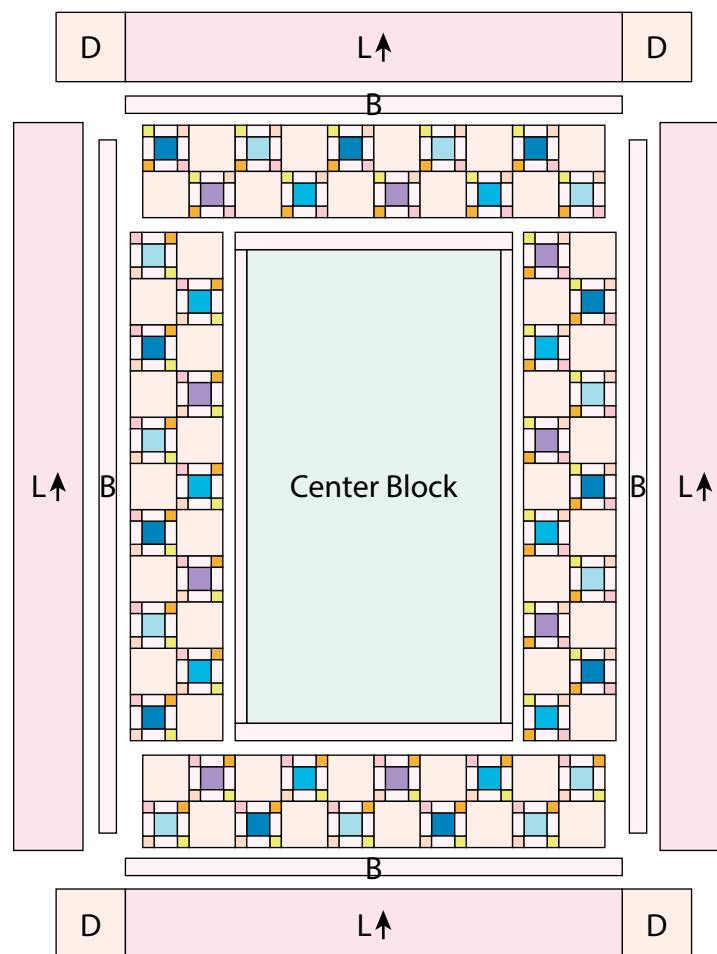
13. Sew (1) 2" x 60 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 43 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

14. Sew (1) 6 1/2" x 63 1/2" Fabric L strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 6 1/2" Fabric D square to each end of (1) 6 1/2" x 43 1/2" Fabric L strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

15. Layer and quilt as desired.

16. Sew the (7) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric M strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

17. Bind as desired.
