Quilt Yardages:

Fabric A:	GFLI 4741 PA	1 panel
Fabric B:	GFLI 4744 B	2/3 yard
Fabric C:	TRAN 4753 B	1/3 yard
Fabric D:	TRAN 4753 DT	1/2 yard
Fabric E:	TRAN 4753 LY	1/3 yard
Fabric F:	TRAN 4753 O	1/4 yard
Backing:	GFLI 4746 B suggested	3 yards
Batting:		50" x 50"

Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric (perpendicular to selvedges) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

From Fabric A:

1. Cut five blocks 12 1/2" x 12 1/2" centering design within each block.

From Fabric B:

- Cut four 2 1/2" strips; subcut two 2 1/2" x 38 1/2" strips and two 2 1/2" x 42 1/2" strips. Note: cut as close to selvages as possible to ensure 42 1/2" strips. Enough yardage was allowed if you choose to piece strips for length. (Outer Border)
- 2. Cut one 9" strip; subcut four 9" squares. (Alternate Blocks) From Fabric C:
- 1. Cut one 7 1/4" strip; subcut four 7 1/4" squares. Cut each square diagonally in both directions to yield sixteen quarter-square triangles. (Alternate Blocks)

From Fabric D:

1. Cut five 2 1/2" strips. (Binding)

From Fabric E:

1. Cut one 7 1/4" strip; subcut four 7 1/4" squares. Cut each square diagonally in both directions to yield sixteen quarter-square triangles. (Alternate Blocks)

From Fabric F:

1. Cut four 1 1/2" strips; subcut two 1 1/2" x 36 1/2" strips and two 1 1/2" x 38 1/2" strips. (Inner Border)

Piecing Instructions:

1. Sew one 7 1/4" C triangle to one 7 1/4" E triangle along short sides as shown. Press toward C. Repeat to make sixteen units. (Figure 1)



2. Sew one Step 1 unit to all sides of one 9" B square to complete one block. Press seams open. Repeat to make four blocks. (Figure 2)

- 3. Referring to Quilt Diagram, place 12 1/2" A panel blocks alternately with blocks made in Step 2, into rows. Sew blocks into rows and press toward A blocks in each row. Sew rows together and press seams open or to one side.
- 4. Sew one 1 1/2" x 36 1/2" F strip to both sides of the quilt center. Press toward F. Sew one 1 1/2" x 38 1/2" F strip to the top and bottom of quilt center; press.
- Sew one 2 1/2" x 38 1/2" B strip to both sides of the quilt.
 Press toward B. Sew one 2 1/2" x 42 1/2" B strip to the top and bottom of the quilt; press. Press toward F.

Finishing:

- 1. Prepare backing using two widths. Press seams open. Trim to 50" x 50".
- 2. Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
- 3. Quilt as desired.
- 4. Trim layers even with quilt top squaring corners.
- Join five 2 1/2" D binding strips with diagonal seams.
 Press seams open. Attach binding using your favorite method.
- 6. Make a label and sew to the back of quilt.
