## Quilt Yardages:

## Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric (perpendicular to selvedges) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with a $1 / 4$ " seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

## From Fabric A:

1. Cut five blocks $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ centering design within each block.

## From Fabric B:

1. Cut four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips; subcut two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 381 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 421 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Note: cut as close to selvages as possible to ensure 42 1/2" strips. Enough yardage was allowed if you choose to piece strips for length. (Outer Border)
2. Cut one 9" strip; subcut four 9" squares. (Alternate Blocks)

## From Fabric C:

1. Cut one $71 / 4$ " strip; subcut four $71 / 4$ squares. Cut each square diagonally in both directions to yield sixteen quarter-square triangles. (Alternate Blocks)

## From Fabric D:

1. Cut five $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. (Binding)

## From Fabric E:

1. Cut one $71 / 4$ " strip; subcut four $71 / 4$ " squares. Cut each square diagonally in both directions to yield sixteen quarter-square triangles. (Alternate Blocks)

## From Fabric F:

1. Cut four $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips; subcut two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 361 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and two 1 1/2" x 38 1/2" strips. (Inner Border)

## Piecing Instructions:

1. Sew one $71 / 4$ " C triangle to one $71 / 4$ " E triangle along short sides as shown. Press toward C. Repeat to make sixteen units. (Figure 1)

2. Sew one Step 1 unit to all sides of one 9 " $B$ square to complete one block. Press seams open. Repeat to make four blocks. (Figure 2)


Figure 2 Make 4. 12 1/2" x 12 1/2" unfinished
3. Referring to Quilt Diagram, place 12 1/2" A panel blocks alternately with blocks made in Step 2, into rows. Sew blocks into rows and press toward A blocks in each row. Sew rows together and press seams open or to one side.
4. Sew one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 361 / 2^{\prime \prime} F$ strip to both sides of the quilt center. Press toward F. Sew one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 381 / 2^{\prime \prime} F$ strip to the top and bottom of quilt center; press.
5. Sew one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 381 / 2^{\prime \prime} B$ strip to both sides of the quilt. Press toward B. Sew one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 421 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ B strip to the top and bottom of the quilt; press. Press toward F.

## Finishing:

1. Prepare backing using two widths. Press seams open. Trim to 50" x 50".
2. Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Trim layers even with quilt top squaring corners.
5. Join five $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{D}$ binding strips with diagonal seams.

Press seams open. Attach binding using your favorite method.
6. Make a label and sew to the back of quilt.
