Additional supplies: Paper to copy foundation pattern for paper-piecing.



Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric (perpendicular to selvages) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

From Fabric A:

1. Cut two 20 1/2" x 20 1/2" panel blocks centering design within each one.

From Fabric B:

1. Cut one 7 1/2" strip; subcut one 7 1/2" square and four 4" squares.

From Fabric C:

1. Cut one 5 7/8" strip; subcut two 5 7/8" squares. Cut each square diagonally in half to yield four half-square triangles.

From Fabric D:

1. Cut five 2 1/2" strips for binding.
2. Cut one 4" strip; subcut four 4" x 6 1/2" rectangles. Cut two rectangles diagonally in half. Cut remaining rectangles diagonally in the opposite direction (yields four reverse triangles).

From Fabric E:

1. Cut one 3 3/8" strip; subcut six 3 3/8" squares. Cut each square diagonally in half to yield twelve half-square triangles.
2. Cut one 4" strip; subcut four 4" x 6 1/2" rectangles. Cut two rectangles diagonally in half. Cut remaining rectangles diagonally in the opposite direction (yields four reverse triangles).

From Fabric F:

1. Cut five 1" strips. Use one strip to cut two 1" x 20 1/2" strips. Sew remaining strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Press seams open. From this pieced strip, cut two 1" x 61 1/2" strips.

From Fabric G:

1. Cut five 1 1/2" strips. Sew strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Press seams open. From this pieced strip, cut two 1 1/2" x 21 1/2" strips and two 1 1/2" x 63 1/2" strips.
2. Cut one 11" strip; subcut four 6" x 11" rectangles. Use remainder of strip to cut two 3 3/8" squares. Cut each square diagonally in half to yield four half-square triangles.

Piecing Instructions:

Note: Diagrams are shown using blue colorway. If you want to use Fabric B as a directional fabric, make a plastic template using the sizes noted in the cutting instructions. Trace template onto fabric and cut.

1. Use pattern provided to copy four paper-piecing foundations.
2. Use one 6" x 11" G rectangle, one and one reverse 4" x 6 1/2" D and E triangles with one paper foundation. Use your preferred method to paper-piece one unit. Repeat to make four units. (Figure 1)

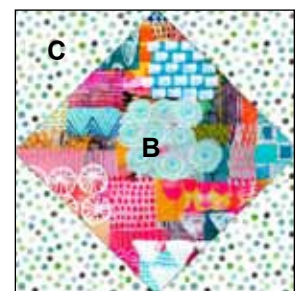


Figure 2 **Make 1.**

3. Sew one 5 7/8" C triangle to opposite sides of the 7 1/2" B square. Press toward C. Sew another set of triangles to remaining sides of the square; press. (Figure 2)

4. Sew one 3 3/8" E triangle to opposite sides of one 4" B square. Press toward E. Sew one 3 3/8" E triangle and one 3 3/8" G triangle to remaining sides of square; press. Repeat to make four units. (Figure 3)
5. Referring to Figure 4, sew Step 2, 3 and 4 units into rows. Press seams open. Sew rows together and press seams open.
6. Sew one 20 1/2" A square to both sides of the pieced block made in Step 5. Press toward A. (Figure 4)

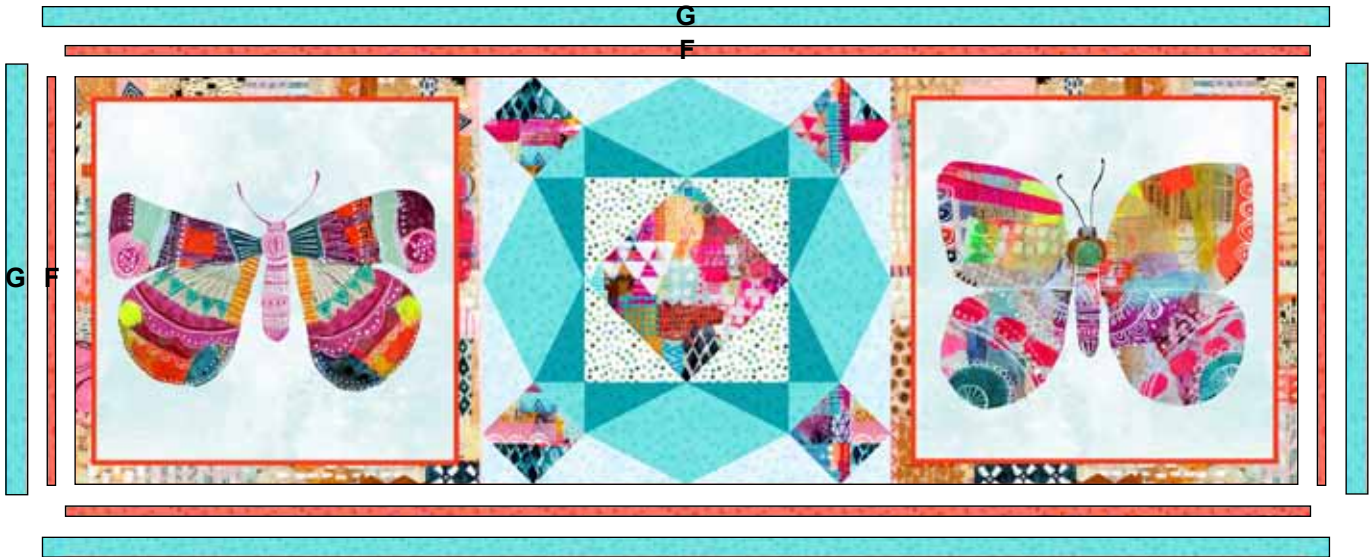

7. Sew one 1" x 20 1/2" F strip to both ends of the runner. Press toward F. Sew one 1" x 61 1/2" F strip to the top and bottom of the runner; press.
8. Sew one 1 1/2" x 21 1/2" G strip to both ends of the runner. Press toward G. Sew one 1 1/2" x 63 1/2" G strip to the top and bottom of the runner; press.

Finishing:

1. Press backing fabric *well*.
2. Layer runner top, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Trim layers even with runner top squaring corners.
5. Join five 2 1/2" D binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Attach binding using your favorite method.
6. Make a label and sew to the back of runner

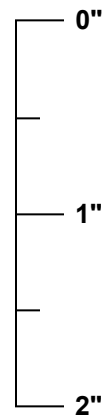
