A deep ruby red wine with notes of berries, liquorice, and dark chocolate. Slight minerality on the nose with a firm and persistent structure, enriched by a frest peppermint finish.	
2020 Ciro Rosso Classico Superiore DOC Cantina Scala Medium ruby with notes of bright red fruit, wood spice and dried violet. The concentrated palate is rich and charming; firm tannic grip and a fresh finish.	<b>\$35</b>
2018 Antano Montefalco Rosso DOC Fattoria Antano A ripe, racy effort laced with dried fruit, wild rose and spice. A medium to full-bodied Rosso where underlying minerality add complexity to the fresh finish. Ageing potential: 8-10 years.	\$41
2020 Chianti Classico DOCG Monteraponi Notes of red cherry, rosemary, balsamic, and chocolate on the nose. At once dense and juicy on the palate, with fresh herb and peppery red berry flavours given grip by lively tannins on the bright, long finish.	\$41
2019 Rosso Di Montalcino DOC Ciro Picariello Full persistent fragrances of ripe plum, dark spice and roasted chestnut. The bright and silky palate offers tart cherry with a mineral streak, refined tannins and fresh acidity.	\$41
2018 Moliss Barbera D'Asti Superiore DOCG Agostino Pavia Intense ruby red with violet reflections. Bouquet of raspberries with a hint of herbs. On the palate the wine is broad and well-structured with good acidity, a a long persistent finish. An immensely versatile food wine.	<b>\$36</b> and
2015 Gattinara DOCG Stefano Vegis Ruby red with fine perfume of small red fruit and sweet tobacco. Intense palat softened by tannins and an incredible mineral finish. From Gattinara's historic most famous cru.	
2018 Barbaresco Ovello DOCG Cascina Morassino The nose is complex and intense. Violets, cherries, liquorice, anise, oriental spices with a lightly toasted note. The palate is austere although smoothened elegant tannins.	<b>\$85</b> by
2016 Brunello Di Montalcino DOCG Casanuova Delle Cerbaie Intense deep ruby red colour with garnet nuances, austere, well-rounded fragrances of truffle, new leather and thyme. Juicy black cherry with white pep and liquorice notes. Dusty tannins.	<b>\$85</b> per
2017 Prapò Barolo DOCG Ettore Germano Tighter and cooler on the nose than the Cerretta, showing subtle notes of blac cherry, flowers and fresh herbs. Most impressive for its suavity, fine-grained intensity and light touch. Firm tannins and a persistent finish make this wine a great cellaring option, though it is still very drinkable now.
