

GENERAL OPERATION

Placing and Answering a Call

To Instigate call Press Intercom Call Button on Door Station The Intercom Monitor will Ring and the Video Image appears Press the Answer button to initiate communication Press the Unlock button to unlock if a locking device is connected Press the Answer button to hang up the call

Viewing the Outdoor Station


Press Monitor Button on the Indoor Monitor

Calling Internal Room Monitors

Press the Internal Call button and ALL monitors in the system will ring At the monitor being called press the Answer button and communication will start Press the Answer button on either monitor to finish the call

MENU OPERATIONS

Note: If a User does not operate any of the functions on the indoor device for 1 minute, the system will enter standby mode automatically



This " 🏶 " button is a 3 way button: Press IN for Enter Scroll UP and DOWN to move cursor to desired location



INSTALLATION

CABLING

Cable diameter of 0.5mm² Stranded (twisted) MUST be used to achieve maximum distances specified.

Recommended: 4 Core Security - 14/020 - 1 Conductors per Bus Line Wire Cat 5 – 1 Pair (2 conductors) per Bus Line Wire

Lock release will require an additional 2 cores for 12V Power feed to door station


Alternative Cables may be used –Cable distances and picture quality may be compromised.

Note: The Lock release on the door station is a RELAY only NO/C – Power is Required if an electric Strike is to be used.


Electric Strike Connection




Momentary Trigger (Door Control)




Request to Exit (Momentary ONLY)
