

Since 1990 GM has used non-standard brake lines on some production vehicles. These non-standard lines are often confused as being a 1/4" diameter tube with an ISO/Bubble flare and a metric fitting. This brake line is actually a new 6mm tube with specialized tube nut. The following are the actual specifications:



As these vehicles age, replacements of these new lines have increased accordingly. These lines are not commonly available through the OE dealer and are generally very expensive. However, AGS now offers a complete assortment of 6mm replacement brake lines. 6mm brake lines are available in Poly-Armour<sup>®</sup> as well as standard steel.
