



BY DESIGN, THE SKIS ARE MORE AGGRESSIVE THAN FACTORY STANDARD SKIS. IF FOR TRAIL RIDING YOU FIND THAT THE SKIS ARE TURNING TO HARD. YOU MAY WANT TO LIGHTEN SKI PRESSURE FOR EASIER TURNING. FOR ASSISTANCE ON LIGHTENING SKI PRESSURE, CONSULT YOUR SNOWMOBILE OWNERS MANUAL OR YOUR SNOWMOBILE DEALER.



## SKI INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS ALIGNMENT

Once the skis are installed, check the distance between the skis. To eliminate darting, we recommend the distance between the front toes of the skis to be 3/8" wider than the back of the skis. To do this, measure the two distances shown and make sure Distance #2 is 3/8" wider than Distance #1. The skis should also be parallel with the snowmobile track (within 3/8", check by taking a straight edge and align it with the track). If the skis are parallel to the track, then they will also be aligned with the straight edge.
