Prim Heirloom Designs Making a Chenille Stem Christmas Tree Onstructions

You will need:

- A 5cm wooden cone 2.5x5cm
- 2 sparkly chenille stems
- Hot Glue Gun

This is a simple way to make a little Christmas Tree that is the PERFECT size for my Dicken's Village Series!

I like using glittery green tinsel stems for it, but it would also look great in any other sparkly stem think of iridescent white or gold, or even trying to combine two colours in one cone!

The cones can be purchased online thorugh a craft supplier or even on Amazon, just keep in mind the size I specify.

And lastly, if you want to glitz it up you could glue on a little star at the top or add on a mini string of beads!

Step 1

Starting at the wide end of the cone, add a bit of hot glue, and glue the end of the chenille stem in place.







Continue to glue and wrap the chenille stem all the way up the cone. You will need two chenille stems to make it all the way!





Trim the excess chenille stem.
