When is the Irish Writers Centre reopening?

The IWC will reopen to Members only initially. We will provide more information on booking for Members from 24th August.

I am a Member, can I still hot-desk in the IWC?

Yes, we will be open for Members to book a classroom for solo use on an appointment basis. We will provide more information on booking for Members from 24th August. We will also accommodate a limited number of small writers groups of up to 8. Drop-ins or walk-ups without an appointment may not be accommodated due to reduced room capacity so we recommend contacting us in advance.

I am not a Member, can I come to the IWC?

Our Autumn programme of courses will commence from Saturday 12th September. The majority of our Autumn programme will be delivered online via Zoom, alongside a limited number of courses we aim to host in the building, dependent on Covid-19 status.
