

Instructions For Use

FlexiSEQ

FOR JOINT WEAR & TEAR

Read the whole leaflet carefully before you start using this product. Keep this leaflet for future reference. If you have any further questions, consult your doctor or pharmacist.

1. Composition

Aqua, Phosphatidylcholine, Glycerin, Alcohol, Carbomer, Disodium Phosphate, Sodium Hydroxide, Polysorbate 80, Benzyl Alcohol, Methylparaben, Ethylparaben, Disodium EDTA, Linalool, Sodium Phosphate, Sodium Metabisulfite, BHT.

2. Presentation and pack size

FlexiSEQ is a white to yellow gel and comes in 50g and 100g tubes.

3. Intended purpose

FlexiSEQ lubricates the cartilage in joints to relieve pain and stiffness and improve impaired joint function associated with all stages of osteoarthritis.

4. Contraindications, precautions and safety measures

- Do not use FlexiSEQ if you are allergic (hypersensitive) to any of the ingredients.
- Do not use FlexiSEQ on open wounds, broken or infected skin or mucous membranes (the lining of the openings of the body, such as the mouth, nose or eyes).
- In case of minor skin irritations such as dryness and redness at the site of application, reduce the frequency of application to once daily. If this does not improve the condition, you may discontinue application until the problem resolves, usually within a few days. You may then restart the application. If the problem persists then discontinue use.
- There are no known interactions with medicines.
- Keep out of the reach of children.
- FlexiSEQ has not been tested on pregnant women or children.
- In the event of serious side effects, or if you notice any side effects not listed in this leaflet, please tell your doctor or pharmacist.

HOW TO GET THE BEST FROM FLEXISEQ

Application	Drying Time	Frequency	Effect Time	Storage
<p>Spread a thin layer around the joint and do NOT rub it in. Allow to dry.</p>	<p>Once applied, the correct amount should take roughly 10 minutes to air dry.</p>	<p>You should look to apply FlexiSEQ twice daily in the morning and evening.</p>	<p>FlexiSEQ can take anywhere between 2-14 days to start taking effect.</p>	<p>Store at room temperature (not in the fridge) and use within three months of opening.</p>

APPLYING FLEXISEQ TO YOUR JOINTS

FlexiSEQ is not like other gels. It is important to apply our gel correctly to joints to ensure it works effectively. It should **NOT** be rubbed into the skin. It should be allowed to dry completely.

Hands	Hips	Knees	Shoulders
<p>Apply a pea-sized amount of gel to each affected knuckle and spread evenly around the joint. Avoid washing hands for 10-15 minutes.</p>	<p>Locate the edge of your hip bone and apply a line of gel as long as your index finger to the soft tissue below, where the bone can no longer be felt.</p>	<p>Apply a line of gel as long as your index finger to the back and sides of your knee joint. It should not be applied to the kneecap.</p>	<p>Apply a line of gel as long as your index finger to the area corresponding to your pain. It should not be applied to the bone or shoulder blade.</p>
