

OUR FAVORITE PLACES TO PADDLE

- Enter the Pigeon River at the Park 'n Ride at the bottom of LS, just north of Eisner Ave in Sheboygan. You can paddle east (to your left when you enter the water) and go to the mouth of Lake Michigan. It's a beautiful, calm paddle with gorgeous scenery and wildlife. There is sometimes a shallow spot shortly after you begin paddling, but you can easily get through it by using your paddle to push off the river bottom or getting out and pulling your kayak a few feet until it starts to deepen again.
- Enter across from Kiwanis Park in Sheboygan, just north of the Biergarten. **Do not use the kayak launch with inflatable kayaks as it can damage the skeg. Paddle through the industrial area, the Sheboygan Riverfront area near Pacifico, and to the mouth of the lake near Blue Harbor Resort.
- Enter at Esslingen Park in Sheboygan, just west of Taylor Drive. Paddle east to see various parts of the city, riverfront, and to the mouth of Lake Michigan.
- Sheboygan County has a great variety of small, inland lakes that make for great kayaking. If you are visiting an inland lake, simply use your search engine to look up boat landings, no-wake hours, and more.
