CLEAN-UP AND DISPOSAL

Clean the equipment with lacquer thinner, acetone, or alcohol. Follow safety warnings on solvents, and provide adequate ventilation. Clean epoxy hardener residue with warm soapy water.

DO NOT dispose of resin and hardener in a liquid state. Waste resin and hardener can be mixed and cure (in small quantities) to a non-hazardous inert solid.

STORAGE

MAKEART® RIVER 1888 resin and hardener will keep for 2 years if kept in original containers at room temperature (15°C to 32°C) and out of direct sunlight. Containers should be tightly sealed to prevent moisture absorption.
