
Mid Section Sofa














Corner Section Sofa - (Right Arm)














Corner Section Sofa - (Left Arm)













Maintenance Attention

Rattan furniture is easy to clean and take care of.

- 1. You generally only need to rinse it thoroughly with clean water to wash away dirt and grime.
- 2. For the stubborn grime and stains, it can be cleaned gently with a soft sponge and mild soapy water. Dry it with a cloth or paper towel.
- 3. Store resin furniture during the off-season, optional instead for covering the furniture with a tarp or other protective cover and put it in a spot outside. where it is sheltered somewhat from the worst of the winter weather.
- 4. Wipe car wax onto the pieces every two years. It will add a shine to the furniture.
- 5. Keep resin furniture away from heat sources such as an outdoor grill. The extreme temperatures could cause the plastic to melt.

Tips & Warnings

Never use abrasive cleansers on resin furniture.
