

Universal Rear View Camera Installation Guide

For specific cable routing and trim removal, please do your own research, as we cannot offer advice on specific models.

- 1. **Mounting the Camera:**
 - Drill a hole in the number plate light trim to mount the camera securely.
- 2. **Connect Ground Wire:**
 - Connect the black wire from the camera loom to the ground on your reverse light.
- 3. **Connect Power Wires:**
 - Connect the two red wires from the camera loom to the live wire of the reverse light.
- 4. **Route Video Wire:**
 - Route the yellow video wire (yellow connector) from the boot to the module or decoder location.
- 5. **Connect Video Wire to Module:**
- Plug in the yellow video connector to the decoder or module loom and the red cable to the reverse wire on the decoder or module.
- 6. **Connect Camera Loom:**
- Connect the yellow and red connectors from the camera to the corresponding connectors on the camera's loom.
- 7. **Configure Decoder or Module:**
 - Set the decoder or module to recognize an aftermarket camera instead of the OEM camera.
- 8. **Test the Camera:**
 - Test the camera by selecting reverse to ensure proper functionality.
- 9. **Reinstall Car Trims:**
 - Reinstall any removed car trims as required for a clean and finished installation.

Note: Ensure all connections are secure and follow standard safety practices during the installation process.
