

Iris Vineyards 2014 Aroha Syrah



Tasting Notes: This wine is a beautiful garnet color, with aromas of blackberry, tarragon, and black-strap molasses. On the palate, flavors allude to white pepper and Italian prune while finishing with ample tannins.

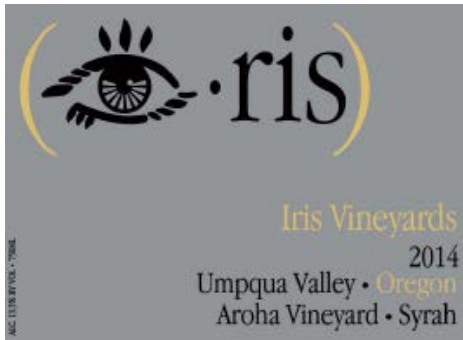
Growing Season: The 2014 growing season in the Umpqua Valley started earlier than normal with bud break arriving around March 15th. The summer was long, warm and dry; due to this, ripening moved very quickly. All the fruit was handpicked and the last day of picking was September 28th.

Case Production: 84 Cases

Cooperage: Aged in French Oak barrels for 11 months

Final Analysis: 13.6% alcohol, TA 5.8g/L, pH 3.69

Vineyard Source: 100% Aroha Vineyard
