

Iris Vineyards 2014 Oregon Pinot Noir



Tasting Notes: Showcasing aromas of raspberry, cranberry, salmonberry and wet stone; this refreshing wine offers a perky acidity, crisp tannins, and a smooth finish.

Growing Season: The 2014 growing season at our Chalice Vineyards, which is nestled in the foothills of the Oregon Coastal Range, started out with bud break occurring very near the average date. We continued to have good weather throughout the growing season, though heading into summer we began experiencing warmer than normal days, having daytime highs greater than 90°F. Weather remained dry through harvest.

Cooperage: 8 months in barrel

Final Analysis: 13.7 Alcohol, TA 5.8 g/L, pH 3.57

Vineyard Source: 66% Chalice Estate, 14% Umpqua Valley
10% Willamette Valley, 10% Dundee Hills
