

Purse / Shoulder Bag Transferring Instructions

Read instructions completely before you begin.

Description:

These fun and stylish shoulder bags are different, cool and sure to please. They feature a white imprintable flap that snaps off for easy imaging, and then snaps back on the bag – ready to wear! Additional flaps are available, making one bag work for every occasion. The body of the bag has a black satin look, finished with a sturdy adjustable strap. Available in two sizes: small and medium.

Supplies Needed

- Purse/Shoulder Bag
- Heat Tape
- Heat Gloves

Step 1: Adjust the Heat Press

Oven Temperature: 320° F - 390° F, based on type of pressing – See below

Dwell Time: 10 - 60 seconds, depending on type of pressing – See below

Note: These instructions, including transfer times and temperatures, are based on the inks, paper, ovens and products we use. Your inks, papers, etc. may require adjustments in your time/temp settings.

Step 2: Design and Print Your Transfers

- Prepare artwork and size transfer with consideration to the size of the bag flap.
- **Mirror Image**: Image must always be produced in reverse to ensure right reading image once pressed into a garment. Most printers refer to this as "Flip Horizontal" or "Mirror".

Step 3: Transfer the Image

Transferring instructions vary based on the type of printing/pressing you will be doing. Please refer to sections 3.a-3.d below for instructions specific to your application.

3.a: Dye Sub Pressing

- 1. Preheat press to 390° F.
- 2. Lay a sheet of white paper on the bottom of the press.
- 3. Using heat resistant tape, fasten the transfer image side down.
- 4. Place the flap on the heat press with the transfer on top.
- 5. Cover transfer with a sheet of plain white paper.
- 6. Press at 390° F for 60 seconds using Light to Medium pressure.
- 7. Remove transfer while hot.

3.b: OEM Inkjet Pressing

- 1. Preheat press to 320° F.
- 2. Lay a sheet of white paper on the bottom of the press.
- 3. Place the flap on the heat press with the transfer on top.
- 4. Cover transfer with a sheet of plain white paper.
- 5. Press at 320° F for 40 seconds using Light to Medium pressure.
- 6. Remove transfer while hot.

3.c: Laser Pressing (CL/CL Non-Oil)

- 1. Preheat press to 375° F.
- 2. Lay a sheet of white paper on the bottom of the press.
- 3. Place the flap in the heat press with the transfer on top.
- 4. Cover transfer with a sheet of plain white paper.
- 5. Press at 375° F for 20 seconds using Light to Medium pressure.
- 6. Remove transfer while hot.

3.d: Laser Pressing (CL Non-Oil YG)

- 1. Preheat press to 375° F.
- 2. Print transfer paper in "Right Reading" (NOT in mirror image).
- 3. Lay a sheet of plain white paper on the press.
- 4. Place the flap on the press white side up.
- 5. Place imaged film on top of the flap.
- 6. Cover film with silicon paper.
- 7. Press at 375° F for 10 seconds using Light to Medium pressure.
- 8. Remove transfer when cool (not hot).

Tips and Washing Instructions:

- Use a wet cloth with mild detergent to gently wipe the surface of the bag.
- Bags should not be washed in the washing machine or soaked in water.
