




PORTABLE FOLDING KAYAK

We use special formulation of polypropylene materials (low density grid plate) to make our kayak have the strength and streamlined design of hard boats, and better water resistance performance than inflatable kayak. Our kayak has excellent controllability, and can be directly placed in trunk of any car after folding.




THE ASSEMBLY PROCESS OF FOLDING KAYAK

Push along the fold lines as shown to pop out the inverted folds and form the shape of the kayak(Pic 3,Pic 4).







Install the support rod as shown in (Pic 5).


Make sure the hull folds are pushed out completely ($\operatorname{Pic} 6$) . Fix the pedal to the bow hole point A (Pic 7). Fix the seat to point B seat fixing plate (Pic 8). Pic 7 Pic 8 Pic 6




Fasten the plastic lock on the bow and tighten it as shown in (Pic 9).


STEP9 Close the bow and insert the installation deck strip from the cockpit direction(Pic 10).

STEP10 Tighten and fasten the Velcro on the bow as shown in the pic(Pic 11).




fasten the Plastic lock on the bow and tighten it as show in (Pic 12).


Close the stern deck and install the deck strips from the stern direction as shown in the pic(Pic 13).

Tighten the two buckles as shown in the figure and stick them on the deck(Pic 14).










THE ASSEMBLY PROCESS OF FOLDING KAYAK

lock the buckles at the three places A, B, and C as shown in the figure, and adjust the tightness(Pic 15).

As shown in the pic, the buckle is locked, and the length of the Strap can be adjusted as needed to achieve the purpose of adjusting the seat and pedals(Pic 16) (Pic 17).

CHECK THE FOLLOWING ITEMS AGAIN:

Whether the folding hull is fully unfolded and whether the stern support rod is installed.
All footrest and seat are hooked and tightened.
All the buckles are locked, and the length of the webbing is adjusted appropriately.
All deck strips are installed in place, and the waterproof cover covers both ends .

Your kayak has been installed.










UNCLIP BUCKLES/REMOVE PARTS

Unlock all the buckles, remove the seat, pedals and deck bars and put them aside until step 7(Pic 1).

STEP2 Shift the support rod and fix it on the buckle(Pic 2).










FOLDING KAYAK STERN

Fold the stern towards the seat fixing plate(Pic 3).

Hold the edge of the kayak with one hand, push down along the fold line printed at A with the other hand to eject the fold, and repeat the operation along the other side to push the fold line at B.(Pic 4).





NOTICE:

Folding starts from the stern first, and the front and rear directions are printed on the seat fixing plate.


FOLDING KAYAK BOW


STEP5

Fold the bow of the kayak towards the seat fixing plate(Pic 5).

STEP6

Hold the edge of the kayak with one hand, push down along the fold line printed at A with the other hand to eject the fold, and repeat the operation along the other side to push the fold line at B(Pic 6).






NOTICE:

Go slow the first couple of times you box up your boat. This will allow your kayak to develop proper fold memory.

STORAGE ACCESSORIES




Put the three parts into the corresponding position of the kayak as shown in the figure (Pic 7).






CLOSE THE BOX



Close the two halves of the kayak, lock the buckle, and fully tighten the box closure strap. (Pic 8 Pic 9).







SAFETY GUIDE



- 1. AS kayaking is an active sport it may lead to dangerous situations if do not follow the safety rules.
- 2. Please acquaint yourself with detailed safety instructions and devices beginning your kayaking experience.
- 3. When safety rules are not followed ,all responsibility for accidents lies with the kayak operator.

BEFORE YOU GO KAYAKING



- 2. You must not go kayaking if you are not feeling well or after drinking.
- 3. Please go kayaking after adequate practice and stretching.
- 4. You must pay careful attention to the weather before you go kayaking.
- 5. If you notice a sudden change in the weather, Pleas get out of the water immediately.

BEAUFORT WIND SCALE

- 1. You may go kayaking in conditions up to the third level (gentle breeze)of the Beaufort Wind Scale.
- 2. You must not go kayaking windy conditions starting form the fourth level (moderate breeze)
- 3. The beaufort wind seale is not an absolute criteria for judging wind conditions .

However, you are advised to use the scale when you go kayaking because it can help you judge wind speed when used along with observations made with the naked eye.

Note: The wind speed shown in this table refers to the wind speed at 10 meters above ground level By the wind vector, said the wind from the wind and the wind feathers composition. Wind to the stalk refers to the wind industry, there are eight directions.

Wind Feather: Windshed from 3, 4, and dashes indicate winds, vertical to the right end of the wind direction (northern hemisphere).
