



INTERACTIVE WALLPAPER INSTALLATION & CARE GUIDE

YOU WILL NEED:

- Water Spray Bottle
- Clean Cloth

PREPARE



Before installing your Interactive Wallpaper, ensure that your walls are sealed and smooth. Clean the wall surface. Priming is always recommended for best results, especially with old, damaged or flaking paint and on a wall with uneven surfaces. This material is suitable for indoor use only.

Install with care. We cannot accept liability for defects that are apparent at the time of hanging, nor can we be responsible for any consequential loss.

Let's begin!

SPRAY



Fill your spray bottle with tap water. A standard spray bottle can be used. Lay your wallpaper face down on a clean surface. Spray the back of the paper with water starting from one end and working your way to the other. Check that the surface of the wallpaper is visibly saturated with water. If not, apply more water using the spray bottle. We recommend water to be applied at a rate of 4oz (100ml) per 11ft² (1m²).

INSTALL



Place your wallpaper in your desired location on your wall. Make sure it is aligned and straight before smoothing out. The material can easily be re-positioned and re-aligned during the first 10 minutes of installation. If the material is not moving easily, simply lift up the material and apply more water. Using your hand, work from the top to the bottom to smooth the artwork onto the wall. Making sure to remove any bubbles or wrinkles as you go. If needed, add more water to any areas that haven't stuck. Use a clean cloth to clean any excess paste or water.

Easy To Clean

To clean, gently wipe away any marks as quickly as possible with a clean damp cloth. Do not use any chemicals. Dry off immediately with a new dry cloth. Do not scrub. Some stains may not be able to be removed.

Removal

When it's time to remove the wallpaper (or replace with a cool new design), the product can be easily taken off in one piece. Use your water spray bottle and thoroughly wet the art work, starting from the top and working your way to the bottom. Keeping the material wet, you will be able to slowly peel it from the wall and recover a clean wall.

If your wall was not well prepared or installed properly as outlined above, you may not achieve one piece removal.
