MARCH LENTEN TRIVIA

- Lent was formalized in 325 C.E.
- The Wednesday before Easter is called Spy Wednesday because Judas spied on Jesus and his disciples in the garden of Gethsemane
- "Alleluia" was not said during Lent so it would remain special and used to celebrate and praise God on Easter Sunday
- Traditionally there are 40 days of Lent, (but they do not include Sundays, they do include Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday)
- The 40th day is the Holy Saturday, the Day before Easter
- Jesus spent 40 days fasting and being tempted in the desert
- Up until 1966 Catholic Church law prohibited meat on all Fridays. A new law was implemented in 1983 to "abstain from meat" in observance of Ash Wednesday, the Friday of the Passion and the Death of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Whether Christians observe Lent or not, what really matters is our embrace of Christ crucified and the empty tomb.
