#### **BRAIN DEAD!**

I was asked to write an article for the October church newsletter and this is how I felt brain dead! When I was teaching I always had an idea for the school newsletter. The topic centered around what we were studying in science class. I kept the parents updated on what their child was working on in science class. Reminding them of the importance of completing assignments and behavior in class.

This past week I had to supervise work in the Arapahoe Outdoor Classroom. Inmates come down from the Work Ethic Camp in McCook to help trim, weed eat, and clean the flower beds. When inmates came down I was apprehensive about being around them and telling them what to do. I soon learned that they were just as human as I was. Some men shared their own stories as to why they were in confinement. As they shared their story they didn't always blame others for their prison term. Most of the fellas told me they had done was wrong, and they needed to pay their penalty. They told me that while in confinement they were working on their spiritual life. The gentlemen always treated me with respect and appreciation. I soon learned they were there to work and wanted to help out. The guards that came with them mentioned the men appreciated being told how much I liked their work. They wanted to hear it from me, that I, appreciated their work.

Read through Psalms 1: 1-2, and think about what is written as a map for living as God's people. "Oh, the joys of those who do not follow the advice of the wicked, or stand around with sinners, or join in with scoffers. 2. But they delight in doing everything the Lord wants: day and night they think of his law." Verse 1 acts as a guide to happiness. It points out wisdom about how to make it through life happy. What does it mean to be happy or blessed? Verse 1 is describing happy as a state of being blessed. This is true, but it is a result of God's actions. How do we live in the manner? The key to verse 1 is to be shaped by God so that we are influencers of the world rather than persons who are influenced by the world. Verse 2 serves as a guide and road map to the good and happy life. This verse describes the happy person as one who delights in the law of the Lord and meditates on it moment by moment. How do we learn to delight in the Word? We can pray these words: Lord let me be aware of the riches of your Word, not so that I may become a master of Scripture but so that the Scripture masters me. Are you going to help influence someone life this month? What role will the Scriptures play in your daily life? Believe in someone and listen to their story. Pray with them.

Continue to grow together as one body in Christ.


