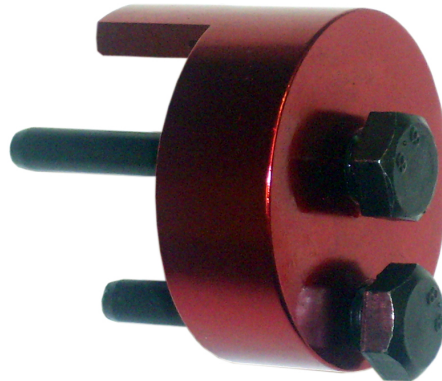
CAUTION: To prevent injury, always wear gloves and eye protection that meets ANSI Z87.1 and OSHA standards.
CAUTION: To prevent equipment damage, clean and lubricate threaded screws and holes before and after use.

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Locate the stretch belt on the vehicle that needs to be installed or replaced. Refer to the vehicle's service manual for details on accessing the belt.
2. Thread the stretch belt through the installation tool, centering it between the tips. Ensure the belt is not twisted.
3. Position the installation tool and belt around the pulleys, aligning the belt with the pulley grooves.
4. Turn the installation tool clockwise while holding the tool firmly in position. This will stretch the belt and allow it to be installed around the pulleys.
5. Continue turning the handle until the belt is fully stretched and seated properly in the pulley grooves.
6. Remove the installation tool. The tension from the stretched belt will hold it in place around the pulleys.
7. Spin the pulleys several times by hand to ensure proper alignment and operation.
8. Refer to the vehicle service manual and reset or recalibrate any sensors or systems as required after belt replacement.
9. Confirm proper belt operation by starting the vehicle and testing all functions related to the belt system.
