

BASIC BLUMAT PRESSURE SYSTEM INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

The smart watering system.

Use your hose or water faucet to automate your watering.

Easy to install with just a pair of scissors!



If you have an easy hook up to an outside faucet or hose, here's a great way to get started. This kit has everything you need to set up a small garden or set of pots and you can expand it to do 500 different watering spots, and rows or planter boxes from those spots. Each kit includes: 8 Blumat water sensors, pressure regulator, 7 meters of hose (23'), 1 tee, 1 elbow, 1 hose coupler, 1 hose end-piece.

With just a pair of scissors, you can customize this to many different kinds of plants and spacings. The included Blumat installation guide and catalog should answer all your installation questions.

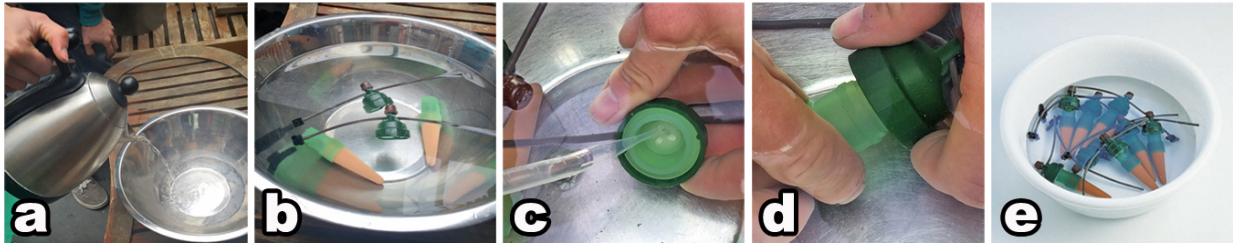

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Water your garden thoroughly, wait a few hours, ideally over-night.
2. CARROT PREPARATION: a) Fill container with cooled non-aerated water (*if not sure, boil & cool first or use bottled water*). b) Unscrew tops and soak both parts for at least 1 hour. c) Then, while underwater, use pipette or eye-dropper to squirt water into one of the holes on the inside of top. d) Keeping under water, screw the tops back on the carrots. e) Soak until ready to use.



3. Start by screwing the pressure regulator onto a hose bibb or the end of a garden hose.
4. Unscrew the output adapter and slide it onto the 8 mm tubing.
5. Push the tubing onto the nipple and screw the output adapter back onto the pressure regulator.



6. Run the 8 mm tubing to your plants.
7. Cut with scissors and use the fittings to lay the tubing around your planting space.

8. Water the garden again, push the Blumat Carrot in where you would like the moisture sensed. Cut the 8 mm tubing and insert the Tee attached to the Blumat Carrot.
9. For the last Carrot, use the elbow insert instead of the tee. >>
10. Turn on the water and adjust the flow on the carrots per instructions in enclosed booklet
