Worm Casting Tea (Not For Human Consumption)

Supplies need

- 1 Worm Casting Tea Brew Kit
- 1 five-gallon bucket
- 4.5 gallons of rainwater or tap water that has been left to sit for 24 hours to reduce chlorine.
- If desired, a small pump and air stone to aerate the tea.

Brewing instructions

Add 4.5 gallons of dechlorinated water to a clean 5-gallon bucket, suspend the tea bag in the bucket. Pour in the microbe food packet. Allow the tea to steep for 24-36 hours. If desired, place the air stone in the bucket and start the pump. Facilitate the brewing process by stirring your tea bucket or agitating the tea bag periodically.

Using your Worm Castings Tea

Tea can be used full strength or mixed 1:1 with water. Use as a soil drench to the root area of plants or in a sprayer as a foliar spray. Use the leftover worm castings as an organic side-dressing or mix in as an organic soil amendment.
