Now made with 100% recycled and recyclable plastic, Aura3 will save an equivalent of 3.43 million plastic bottles each year\*.





## 70% smaller

## 50% smaller

Based on the previous version size: 35.8cmH x 51.3cmW x 11.8cmD and new size 25.6cmH x 38.5cmW x 18cmD.







## The **future** is brighter, greener and more compact.

New compact sizes mean more product can be shipped in a single container, drastically reducing our carbon footprint.

By reducing the size of our products, not only are we saving on materials, we are saving on shipping space.

For example our Vision™ wall stations have been redeveloped with this in mind and as a result we can fit 42% more product into a container.

# Our commitment to change.

### **GREEN TEAM**

A team of Reliance Medical volunteers that are passionate about improving our green credentials. The team presents ideas back to the board on improvements. The team has already removed single use plastic bottles from the business and replaced them with refillable water bottles topped up from large dispensers.



## **SOLAR POWER**

The roof of our warehouse holds a 15kw solar farm powering the business infrastructure and vehicle fleet.

## **ELECTRIC VEHICLES**

Reliance Medical will not put any new combustion engine vehicles into their fleet.

Over 60% of the fleet is already fully electric and the remaining cars will transition over the next 12 months.
