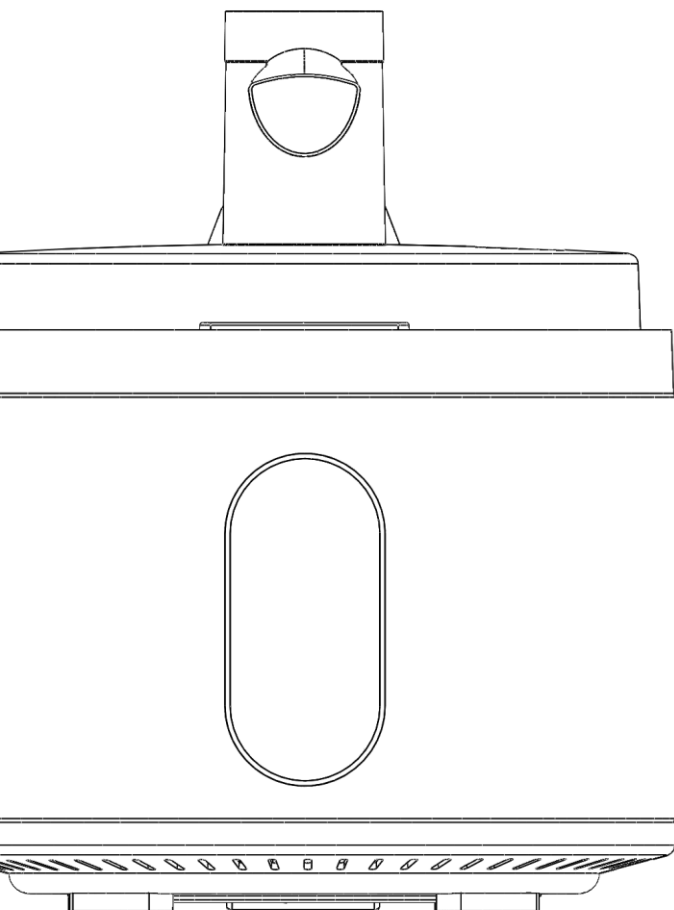

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General Safety Instructions

General Safety Instructions

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed:

1. READ THE *GETTING STARTED GUIDE* AND ALL INSTRUCTIONS, SAFEGUARDS, AND WARNINGS BEFORE OPERATING THE APPLIANCE. FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE SAFEGUARDS AND INSTRUCTIONS MAY RESULT IN INJURY AND/OR PROPERTY DAMAGE.
2. **⚠️ WARNING** The Appetite Automatic Pap Maker is a non-pressurized appliance. Use only the Appetite Automatic Pap Maker lid with the Appetite Automatic Pap Maker cooker body. Using any other lids may cause injury and/or damage.
3. **⚠️ WARNING** To avoid any damage to the appliance, DO NOT use the Lid Stand when opening, closing and maneuvering the lid. Refer to [Product, Parts and Accessories](#).
4. **⚠️ WARNING** To avoid any damage to the appliance, DO NOT splash or submerge the lid and the cooker body in water. Clean the outside and the inside of the lid and cooker body with a dry or damp cloth only.
5. To avoid any damages, cook only in an authorized Appetite inner pot. DO NOT use the appliance without the removable inner pot installed.
6. Always operate the appliance on a stable, non-combustible, level surface.
7. Do not use the appliance for anything other than its intended use. Failure to follow these instructions may result in injury or property damage.
8. For household use only. Do not use outdoors. Not for commercial use.
9. **⚠️ CAUTION** Do not place the appliance on or in close proximity to a hot gas or electric burner, or a heated oven. Heat from an external source will damage the appliance. Failure to follow these instructions may result in injury or property damage.
10. **⚠️ CAUTION** Do not use the appliance near water or flame. Keep out of direct sunlight. Failure to follow these instructions may result in injury or property damage.
11. **⚠️ CAUTION** Do not touch hot surfaces. Only use side handles for carrying or moving. Extreme caution must be used when moving the appliance containing hot liquids. Do not move the appliance when it is under operation.
12. The cooker body contains electrical components. To avoid electrical shock, do not put liquid of any kind into cooker body, and do not immerse power cord, plug, or the appliance in water or other liquid. Do not rinse the appliance under tap.

13.  Do not fill over the label Portion 4 as indicated on the inner pot. Overfilling may cause a risk of clogging the steam release pipe and damage to the appliance.
14.  This appliance cooks under agitation. Inappropriate use may result in burns, injury and/or property damage. Make certain the appliance is properly closed before operating. Refer to **How to Section**
15. When cooking meat with skin (e.g. sausage with casing), the skin can swell when heated. Do not pierce the skin while it is swollen; this could result in scalding injury.
16.  When cooking food with a doughy or thick texture, or a high fat/oil content, contents may splatter when opening the lid. Please follow recipe instructions for pressure release method.
17.  Do not open the appliance when in operation. Opening appliance while it is still in operation may lead to sudden release of hot contents and may cause burns or other injuries.
18. Do not use this appliance for deep frying with oil.
19. Do not lean over or place your hands or face over the steam release valve when the appliance is in operation or has residual steam. Do not touch the inner metal portion of the lid immediately after the appliance is in operation; this could result in injury.
20. Do not cover or obstruct the steam release valve/the lid and/or the bottom cover with cloth or other objects. Obstructing the steam release valve/the lid and/or the bottom cover can create a safety issue and may cause injury.

21. Turn the appliance off if steam escapes from the sides of the lid and ensure sealing ring is properly installed. **See Trouble Shooting** for more information.
22. To disconnect, press Cancel for 5 seconds, then remove plug from power source.
23. Unplug from the outlet when not in use, as well as before adding or removing parts or accessories, and before cleaning. To unplug, grasp the plug and pull from the outlet. Never pull from the power cord.
24. Regularly inspect the appliance and power cord. Do not operate the appliance if the power cord or plug is damaged, or after the appliance malfunctions or is dropped or damaged in any manner. For assistance, contact Customer Care at www.appetitesa.com
25. **CAUTION** Do not let the power cord hang over edges of tables or counters, or touch hot surfaces or open flame, including the stovetop.
26. **CAUTION** Spilled food can cause serious burns. A short power-supply cord is provided to reduce the hazards resulting from grabbing, entanglement and tripping.
 - Keep the appliance and cord away from children.
 - Never drape the power cord over edges of tables or counters.
 - Never use below-counter power outlets, and never use with an extension cord.
27. Intended for countertop use only. Keep the appliance on a stable, heat-resistant platform. Do not place on anything that may block the vents on the bottom of the appliance. Do not place on a hot stove.
28. **CAUTION** Do not use any accessories or attachments not authorized by Appetite Inc. The use of attachments not recommended by the manufacturer, may cause a risk of injury, fire or electric shock.
29. **CAUTION** Before inserting the inner pot into the appliance, clean the outer surface of the inner pot and the heating element located on the inner surface of the outer pot with a clean, dry cloth. Ensure they are dry and free of food debris.
30. Do not attempt to repair, replace, or modify components of the appliance, as this may cause electric shock, fire or injury, and will void the warranty.

33. This appliance is NOT to be used by children or by persons with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities. Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used near children and these individuals. Children should not play with this appliance.
34. To prevent personal injury and damage to the appliance, only replace the sealing ring with an authorized Appetite Automatic Pap Maker sealing ring.
35. The use of accessory attachments not recommended by the appliance manufacturer may cause injuries.
36. Proper maintenance is recommended after each use. Refer to [Care and Cleaning](#). Let the appliance cool to room temperature before cleaning or storage.
37. Never connect this appliance to an external timer switch or separate remote-control system.
38. **⚠ CAUTION** DO NOT touch accessories during or immediately after cooking. To avoid personal injury,
 - Always use oven mitts when removing accessories, and to handle the inner pot.
 - Always place hot accessories on a heat resistant surface or cooking plate.
 - Use extreme caution when disposing of hot grease.

Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious injury or property damage.

39. Do not leave the appliance unattended while in use.
40. **⚠ CAUTION** Extreme caution must be used when the inner pot contains hot oil, hot food, or hot liquids. Improper use, including moving the cooker body, may result in personal injury. Do not move the appliance while it is in use.

42. Do not store any materials in the cooker body or inner pot when not in use.

This appliance has a 3-prong grounding plug. To reduce the risk of electric shock, plug the power cord into a grounded (earthed) electrical outlet that is easily accessible.

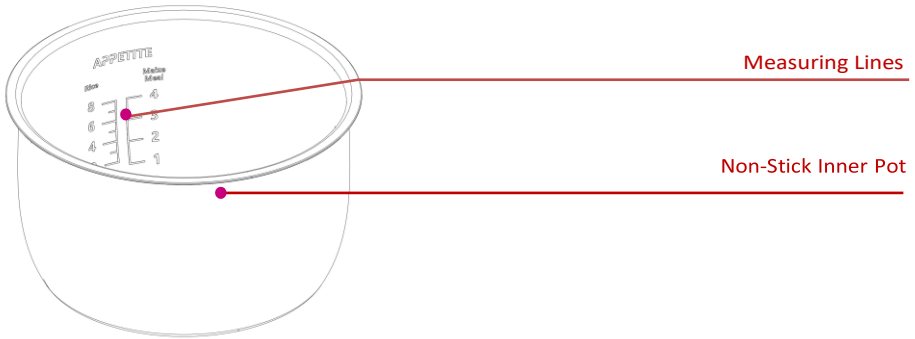

ERR

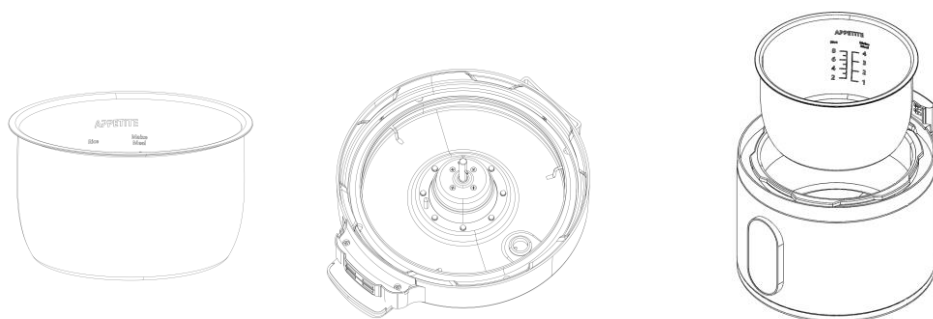
Remove the inner pot and stirrer from the cooker body and wash it with hot water and dish soap. Rinse with warm, clear water and use a soft cloth to dry the outside of the inner pot.

Note: The inner pot and stirrer are dishwasher safe.

Wipe the heating element to ensure it is free of stray packaging particles before returning the inner pot to the cooker body. Failure to do so may damage the cooker.

The inner pot is an integral part of product safety. Food must be placed in the inner pot, and never directly in the cooker body.

To avoid personal injury or damage to the appliance, replace a deformed or damaged inner pot. Use only authorized Appetite inner pots made for the correct model when cooking.

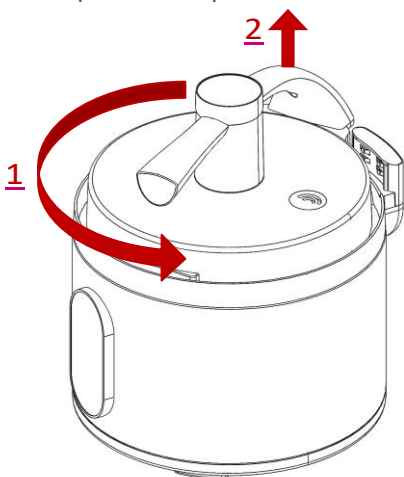
Exercise extreme caution when cooking and venting food such as applesauce, cranberries, pearl barley, oatmeal, split peas, noodles, etc., as these foods may foam, froth, or spatter, and may clog the steam release pipe and/or steam release valve. Do not fill the inner pot higher than the **Portion 2** line when cooking these foods, as indicated on the inner pot.

Fitting and Removing the Lid

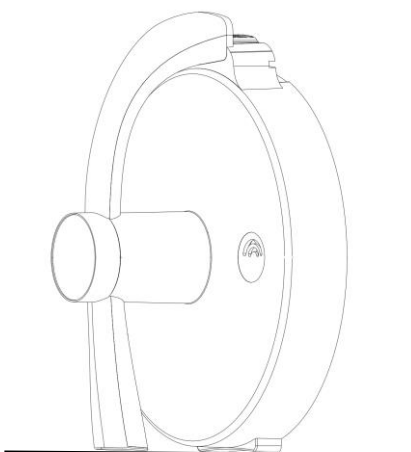
The Appetite Automatic Pap Maker lid included is necessary for most cooking processes, and is essential for making pap and porridge. Always ensure to use the Appetite Automatic Pap Maker lid with the Appetite Automatic Pap Maker cooker body.

Open and Remove the Lid

Grip the lid handle only and turn it counter-clockwise on the lid to fully disengage the electronic connector, then lift the lid up and off the cooker body.



Balancing the Lid

Balance the lid using the Lid stand and the flat surface at the front of the lid on a flat and even surface.

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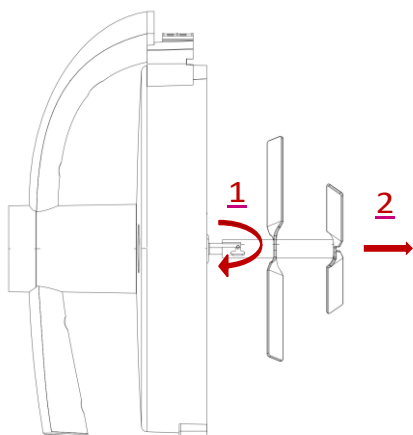
CAUTION

Always check the lid for damage and excessive wear prior to cooking.

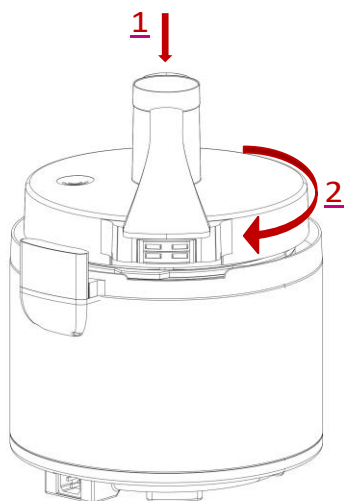

Detaching and Attaching the Stirrer

Align the locking pin on the shaft on the lid to the exit slot on the stirrer by moving the stirrer up or down. Once aligned, rotate and remove the stirrer. To attach the stirrer, align the locking pin with the receiving slot on the stirrer, insert the stirrer and rotate to lock in place.



Close the Lid

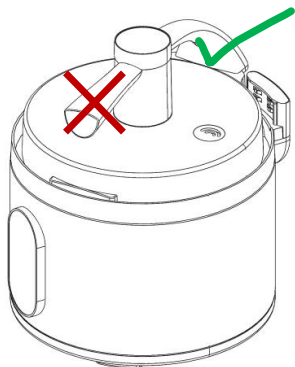
Align the electronic connector on the lid so that it is to the left of the electronic connector on the cooker body and align the rails on the back of the lid so that it is directly above the receiving slots on the rim of the cooker body. Then lower the lid so the rails and the receiving are engaged. Rotate the lid clockwise to lock the lid in place and to couple the electronic connectors.

Sealing Ring

When the lid is closed, the sealing ring installed on the underside of the lid creates an air-tight seal between the lid and the cooker body.

The sealing ring must be installed before using the cooker and should be cleaned after each use. Only 1 sealing ring should be installed in the lid when using the cooker.

Sealing rings stretch over time with normal use. As an integral part of product safety, the sealing ring should be replaced every 12–18 months or sooner if stretching, deformation, or damage is noticed.

Remove the Sealing Ring

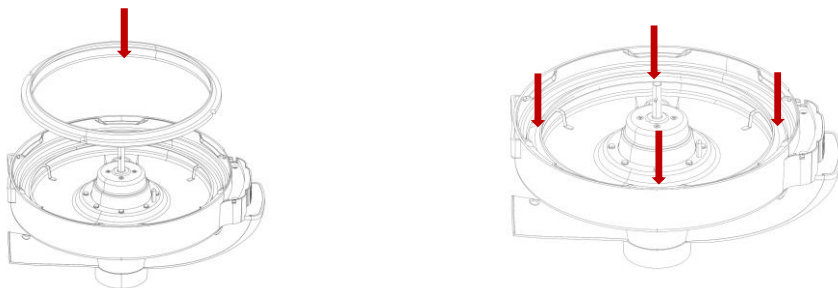
Grip the edge of the silicone rubber and pull the sealing ring out from behind the circular stainless steel sealing ring rack.

With the sealing ring removed, inspect the rack to ensure it is secured, centered, and an even height all the way around the lid. Do not attempt to repair a deformed sealing ring rack.

Install the Sealing Ring

Place the sealing ring over the sealing ring rack and press it into place. Press down firmly to ensure there is no puckering.

When installed properly, the sealing ring is snug behind sealing ring rack and should not fall out when the lid is turned over.

Take Note: Silicone is porous, so it may absorb strong aromas and certain flavors. Keep extra sealing rings on hand to limit the transfer of those aromas and flavors between dishes.




Always check for cuts, deformation, and correct installation of the sealing ring prior to cooking. Do not use a stretched or damaged sealing ring. Only use authorized Appetite sealing rings. Making Stiff Pap

This tutorial will guide you through the preparation of stiff pap using your Appetite Automatic Pap Maker.

1. First, switch on the appliance by pressing the on/off button . The status message  will be shown on the display.
2. Open and place the lid.
3. Then, attach the stirrer.
4. Remove the cooking vessel from the housing body.
5. Ensure the Measuring Cup for maize meal is ready for use.
6. The cooking vessel and stirrer are dishwasher safe.
7. Choose the function Pap  on the control panel. The status message  will be shown on the display.
8. Then select the number of portions on the control panel, using the +  and -  key. The status message  will be shown on the display.
9. Pour the required amount of water into the cooking vessel, under the label Maize Meal, to the number line matching the number of portions you have selected on the appliance.
10. To guarantee the quality of the recipe, ensure you fill the water precisely to the correct level.
11. Dry the outside of the cooking vessel and insert it back into the housing body.
12. Close the lid securely and press OK  to start heating the water. The status message  will be shown on the display.
13. To avoid scratches, ensure the stirrer does not make contact with the cooking vessel when opening and closing the lid.
14. The appliance will notify you once the water is ready. The status message  will be shown on the display.
15. Then open the lid. Beware the inner surface of the lid, the stirrer and the cooking vessel will be hot during and after the preparation.

16. Add the required amount of maize meal into the cooking vessel using the measuring cup.
17. The number of cups of maize meal required matches the number of portions you have selected on the appliance. Please see table below:

1	1
2	2
3	3

18. To guarantee the quality of the recipe, ensure the maize meal is level with the rim of the measuring cup.
19. Close the lid securely to start the cooking process. The status message **COOK** will be shown on the display.
20. Cooking time for each portion is shown in the table below:

Number of Portion Selected	Cooking Time (Minutes)
1	20
2	25
3	30
4	35











21. The cooking process can be stopped at any time by pressing the Cancel **CANCEL** button.
22. Please note once the cooking process has been stopped, it cannot be restarted and the appliance automatically resets the preparation.
23. The appliance will notify you once the cooking process is completed. The status message **Done** will be shown on the display.
24. To avoid any scratches, only use a non-metal spoon or spatula to remove the pap from the cooking vessel.

Making Medium Stiff Pap


This tutorial will guide you through the preparation of stiff pap using your Appetite Automatic Pap Maker.

4. Remove the cooking vessel from the housing body.
5. Ensure the Measuring Cup for maize meal is ready for use.
6. The cooking vessel and stirrer are dishwasher safe.
7. Choose the function Pap  on the control panel. The status message  will be shown on the display.
8. Then select the number of portions on the control panel, using the +  and -  key. The status message  will be shown on the display.
9. Pour the required amount of water into the cooking vessel, under the label Maize Meal, to the number line matching the number of portions you have selected on the appliance.
10. To guarantee the quality of the recipe, ensure you fill the water precisely to the correct level.
11. Dry the outside of the cooking vessel and insert it back into the housing body.
12. Close the lid securely and press OK  to start heating the water. The status message  will be shown on the display.
13. To avoid scratches, ensure the stirrer does not make contact with the cooking vessel when opening and closing the lid.
14. The appliance will notify you once the water is ready. The status message  will be shown on the display.




Making Venda/Pedi (Very Soft) Pap

3. Then, attach the stirrer.
4. Remove the cooking vessel from the housing body.
5. Ensure the Measuring Cup for maize meal is ready for use.
6. The cooking vessel and stirrer are dishwasher safe.
7. Choose the function PAP  on the control panel. The status message  will be shown on the display.
8. Then select the number of portions on the control panel, using the +  and -  key. The status message  will be shown on the display.
9. Pour the required amount of water into the cooking vessel, under the label Maize Meal, to the number line matching the number of portions you have selected on the appliance.
10. To guarantee the quality of the recipe, ensure you fill the water precisely to the correct level.
11. Dry the outside of the cooking vessel and insert it back into the housing body.
12. Close the lid securely and press OK  to start heating the water. The status message  will be shown on the display.
13. To avoid scratches, ensure the stirrer does not make contact with the cooking vessel when opening and closing the lid.
14. The number of cups of maize meal required matches the number of portions you have selected on the appliance. Please see table below:

15. Mix the required amount of maize meal with cold water thoroughly in a separate container using the measuring cup to avoid any lumps.

CAUTION

To avoid any lumps, always mix maize meal with cold water thoroughly when cooking soft pap and porridge (Ratio smaller than 0.5 cup per Number of Portion Selected)



16. The appliance will notify you once the water is ready. The status message **ADD** will be shown on the display.
17. Then open the lid. Beware the inner surface of the lid, the stirrer and the cooking vessel will be hot during and after the preparation.
18. Add the maize meal and cold water mixture into the cooking vessel.
19. Close the lid securely to start the cooking process. The status message **COOK** will be shown on the display.
20. Cooking time for each portion is shown in the table below:

Making Porridge

This tutorial will guide you through the preparation of porridge using your Appetite Automatic Pap Maker.

1. First, switch on the appliance by pressing the on/off button . The status message  will be shown on the display.
2. Open and place the lid.
3. Then, attach the stirrer.
4. Remove the cooking vessel from the housing body.
5. Ensure the Measuring Cup for maize meal is ready for use.
6. The cooking vessel and stirrer are dishwasher safe.
7. Choose the function Porridge  on the control panel. The status message  will be shown on the display.
8. Then select the number of portions on the control panel, using the +  and -  key. The status message  will be shown on the display.
9. Pour the required amount of water into the cooking vessel, under the label Maize Meal, to the number line matching the number of portions you have selected on the appliance.
10. To guarantee the quality of the recipe, ensure you fill the water precisely to the correct level.






This tutorial will guide you through the preparation of Rice using your Appetite Automatic Pap Maker.

1. First, switch on the appliance by pressing the on/off button . The status message  will be shown on the display.
2. Open the lid and detach the stirrer.
3. Remove the cooking vessel from the housing body.
4. Ensure the Measuring Cup for Rice is ready for use.
5. Choose the function Rice  on the control panel. The status message  will be shown on the display.
6. Add the required amount of Rice Grain into the cooking vessel using the measuring cup.
7. Pour the required amount of water into the cooking vessel, under the label Rice, to the number line matching the number of portions you wish to make as illustrated in the table below:



Automatic Cleaning

This tutorial will guide you through the Self-Cleaning function of your Appetite Automatic Pap Maker. The self-cleaning function is most effective after the preparation of stiff pap, soft pap or porridge.

1. First, switch on the appliance by pressing the On/Off button . The status message  will be shown on the display.
2. Remove the cooking vessel from the housing body.
3. Beware, the cooking vessel might be hot from previous food preparations.
4. To avoid any scratches, ensure the stirrer does not make contact with the

cooking vessel when opening or closing the lid.










5. Empty any contents in the cooking vessel by using a non-metal spoon or spatula.
6. Pour the required amount of water into the cooking vessel as indicated by the Portion 4 label on the water line labelled Maize Meal.
7. Dry the outside of the cooking vessel and place the cooking vessel back into the housing body.
8. Close the lid securely as shown.
9. On the control panel, select the Clean  function. The status message  will be shown on the display.
10. Press OK  to start the cleaning cycle.
11. The appliance will notify you once the cleaning cycle is completed. The status message  will be shown on the display.
12. Open and place the lid.
13. Beware, the cooking vessel, stirrer and the inner surface of the lid are hot after the cleaning cycle.
14. After the device has cooled down, using a dry towel, remove the cooking vessel from the housing body and empty the content of the cooking vessel.
15. Remove the stirrer from the lid.
16. Rinse the cooking vessel and stirrer under clean running water to remove any residue.
17. Using a towel, wipe dry the cooking vessel and stirrer.

Multi Cooker Function (Only for Deluxe Model)

This tutorial will guide you through the Manual function of your Appetite Automatic Pap Maker. The Manual function will allow you to use your appliance to achieve normal stove top result.

1. First, switch on the appliance by pressing the On/Off button . The status message  will be shown on the display.
2. Open the lid.

3. On the control panel, select the Manual  function. The status message  will be shown on the display.
4. Use the +  / -  keys to select the level of heat from the heating element. The levels ranges from 100w (lowest), to 1100w(highest). Then press OK  to start cooking.
5. To change the power output during the cooking process, Use the +  / -  keys.
6. Press Cancel  to stop the manual cooking process or alternatively, press and hold the On/Off button  to switch off the appliance.

Cooking Timer Function (Only for Deluxe Model)

This tutorial will guide you through the Cooking Timer function of your Appetite Automatic Pap Maker. The Cooking Timer function can only be engaged when you are cooking in Manual Mode. The Cooking Timer function will allow you to set the cooking time.

1. While cooking in the Manual Function, select the Timer  function. The status message  will be shown on the display.
2. Countdown timer indicates cooking time in hour format: 02:20 is 2 hours, 20 minutes. The user will have to select first the hours and then the minutes desired.
3. Hours – Press the Timer  button, then use the +  / -  keys to select the cooking time. First to select the number of hours required.
After selecting the desired cooking time in hours, press the Timer  key to confirm the number of hours.
4. Minutes - Use the +  / -  keys to select the cooking time in minutes. Press the Timer  key to confirm the number of minutes.
5. Cooking timer indicates cooking time in hour format: 02:20 is 2 hours, 20 minutes.
6. Press OK  to start the timer.
7. To cancel the during the timer, press Cancel  exit Timer mode.
8. When completed, the cooking function will switch off.

Clean your Appetite Automatic Pap Maker after each use. For cleaning after making Pap or Maize Porridge, please see the Automatic Cleaning Function.

Always unplug your Appetite Automatic Pap Maker and let it cool to room temperature before cleaning. Let all surfaces dry thoroughly before use, and before storage.

Difficulty opening lid	Pap is left unattended after cooking is completed for a considerable amount of time. The Pap has hardened and are now stuck to the stirrer.	Open the lid gently, the it will be heavier than usual. Remove the stirrer while the lid is vertically above the cooker body to release the stirrer/pap. Soak the stirrer and lid mixture with hot water for several hours until the stirrer can be removed from the pap.
	Obstruction at the guide rails.	Ensure the guide rails are free of any objects.
