## Expanding the Cast List

The number of speaking parts can easily be increased to approximately 55:

## Narrators

Increase the number of Narrators (to a maximum of fifteen) and spread the lines out accordingly.

## Children

Increase the number of Children (ideally to a maximum of ten) and spread the lines out accordingly.

## Innkeepers

Increase the number of speaking Innkeepers by repeating Joseph asking for a room for the night, for the Innkeepers to reply, "Sorry, we're full up. Try next door."

## Shepherds

Increase the number of speaking Shepherds by repeating Shepherd 4's line, "And me."

## Reducing the Cast List

The number of speaking parts can easily be reduced to approximately 20; simply combine any of the following parts and spread the lines out accordingly:

- Narrators
- Children
- Angels
- Innkeepers
- Shepherds

Several lines in the script are not essential to the story and can simply be cut.
