SCENE 1: WELCOME TO OUR SHOW!

□ Track 1: MEDLEY (OPTIONAL)

Time to get ready for the start of the show! The instrumental Medley welcomes the audience as the cast assemble, ready to begin the performance...

SCENE 2: NAZARETH

A group of Children (Zeek, Tad, Dodo, Midge, Beanie and Skip) enter excitedly.

Zeek: I'm SO excited - I LOVE Christmas!

Tad: Me too!

Skip: (Folding arms, smugly) But do you know what Christmas is

about...?

Dodo: (Excitedly) Presents!

Midge: (Excitedly) Parties!

Beanie: (Rubbing tummy hungrily) Food!

Skip: (Tutting) You've got a lot to learn! Listen...

Narrator 1: Christmas is a special tale -

The best you've ever heard.

Narrator 2: A story from so long ago

We'll tell with magic words...

Everyone: (Impressed) Magic words...?! Ooooo!

Skip: And the first magic word is "Nazareth".

Skip holds up a large piece of card marked with the word "NAZARETH!"

Everyone: (Confused) What's THAT got to do with Christmas?!

Skip: (Tutting) You've got a lot to learn! Listen...

Narrator 3: Our story starts in Nazareth -

Two thousand years ago.

Narrator 4: Where we can meet two people,

Who've stopped to say hello.

The **Children** move to the sides of the stage to allow **Mary** and **Joseph** to enter, and take centre-stage.

Mary: (Waving to the audience) Hello, I'm Mary.

Joseph: (Waving to the audience) Hello, I'm Joseph.

Everyone: (Waving to Mary and Joseph) Hello!

Tad: (Pointing off-stage) Wow, look - angels!

☐ Track 2: ON OFF MUSIC

The Angels enter and stand before Mary.

Angel 1: We're angels from heaven, and we bring you wonderful news.

Angel 2: (To Mary) You're going to have a very special baby!

J Track 3: MARY'S HAVING A BABY

Verse 1 Mary's having a baby,

Mary's having a child. Mary's having a baby, Mary's having a child. Sway in time with the music.

Chorus Listen to the people say,

"Come and wish her well today,"

Listen to the people say,

"Come and wish her well today."

Cup hand to ear.

Raise open arms in a welcoming gesture.

Verse 2 Angels watching from heaven,

The Angels exit.

SCENE 3: THE ROAD TO BETHLEHEM

Mary and Joseph are standing centre-stage, and Zeek, Tad, Dodo, Midge, Beanie and Skip are standing either side.

Tad: The next magic word is "Donkey".

Tad holds up a large piece of card marked with the word "DONKEY!"

Everyone: (Confused) What's THAT got to do with Christmas?!

Mary: Haven't you heard? Everyone in the land has to be counted.

Joseph: So we have to go on a very long journey, back to the town

where I was born.

Midge: But how will you get there ...?

Mary: We'll go by donkey.

Zeek: (Confused) By WHAT...?

Mary and Joseph: By DONKEY!

The **Donkey** enters.

Donkey: Did someone call...?!

Everyone: (Pretending to be donkeys) Ee-or!

Donkey: (To Mary and Joseph) Come on, we should be going - it's a

LONG way. (Yawning loudly) And I'm already tired!

Track 5 / 27: FOLLOW THE DONKEY

SCENE 4: NO ROOM AT THE INN

Mary, Joseph and the Donkey are standing at the back of the stage, and Zeek, Tad, Dodo, Midge, Beanie and Skip are standing either side.

Dodo: The next magic word is "Bethlehem".

Dodo holds up a large piece of card marked with the word "BETHLEHEM!"

Everyone: (Confused) What's THAT got to do with Christmas?!

Mary, Joseph and the Donkey walk wearily to the front of the stage.

Donkey: (Tiredly) Phew! We've made it to Bethlehem - and I'm done

for!

Everyone yawns loudly.

Mary: Me too. We need to find somewhere to sleep.

Narrator 5: But Bethlehem was busy,

By the time that they arrived.

Narrator 6: They couldn't find a single room

To spend the night inside.

J Track 6: ON OFF MUSIC

The **Innkeepers** enter; **Joseph** crosses to them:

Joseph: Hello! Have you got a room for the night?

Innkeeper 1: Sorry, we're full up. Try next door.

Joseph moves on to Innkeeper 2:

Joseph: Hello! Have you got a room for the night?

Innkeeper 2: Sorry, we're full up. Try next door.

Joseph moves on to Innkeeper 3:

Joseph: Hello! Have you got a room for the night?

Innkeeper 3: Sorry, we're full up. And there ISN'T a next door!

Joseph, Mary and the Donkey look very sad.

Track 7: I HEAR YOU KNOCKING

Chorus Knock, knock - I hear you knocking.

Knock, knock - why don't you stop? Knock, knock - I hear you knocking.

Knock, knock - why don't you stop?

Verse 1 We don't have any room for you,

No, no, no - join the queue!

On each "Knock, knock," pretend to knock on a door.

On "I hear you knocking," cup hand to ear.

On each "stop!" hold hand up, palm facing forwards.

Hold hands out to side in despair.

Wag index finger to say, "No!" then point to one side to indicate joining the queue.

Hold hands out to side in despair.

Wag index finger to say, "No!" then point off-stage to say "go away!"

Chorus

Dodo: (Horrified) Oh, no! What are they going to do now...?

Beanie: Don't worry - the next magic word is "Stable".

Beanie holds up a large piece of card marked with the word "STABLE!"

Everyone: (Confused) What's THAT got to do with Christmas?!

Innkeeper 4 suddenly has a bright idea:

Innkeeper 4: Stable...? What a brilliant idea! Why didn't \underline{I} think that?!

Innkeeper 4 rushes over to Mary, Joseph and the Donkey.

Innkeeper 4: WE'VE got a stable - you can stay there!

Joseph: (Sighing thankfully) What a relief - I couldn't walk another

step.

Donkey: (Sighing thankfully) And I couldn't clip another clop!
