SCENE 1: WELCOME TO OUR SHOW!

□ Track 1: MEDLEY (OPTIONAL)

Time to get ready for the start of the show! The instrumental Medley welcomes the audience as the cast assemble, ready to begin the performance...

SCENE 2: THE NORTH POLE

☐ Track 2: ON OFF MUSIC

It's early morning, and everything is calm. The **Elves** enter, greeting each other and getting ready for the new day.

Narrator 1: Welcome to Santa's Workshop.

Narrator 2: Everyone's getting ready for Christmas.

Narrator 3: It's the start of a new day, and the Elves are feeling happy.

☐ Track 3: SUPER-DUPER DAY

Verse 1 It's looking like a super day,
Super-duper day.
We have got so much to do Super-duper day.

Circle arms upwards and outwards, with fingers fluttering.

Jazz hands!

Verse 2 It's looking like a super day,
Super-duper day.
We have got so much to do Super-duper day.
Super-duper day.

Track 4: ON OFF MUSIC

Everyone exits.

SCENE 3: INSIDE SANTA'S HOME

All is quiet, and the stage is empty. There is a large calendar on the wall, with the number "24" written clearly on it.

Narrator 4: But trouble's on the way, because Santa's woken up late!

Santa enters, yawning and stretching his arms wide. He's wearing his pyjamas and a dressing gown.

Santa: Ho! Ho! What a long sleep. I wonder what day it is ...?

Santa walks over to the calendar and sees, with horror, that it's the 24th.

Santa: Oh, no - the 24th! It's Christmas Eve!

Santa picks up a long list of "Things to do". The chief Elves - Doodle, Dipsy, Dazzle, Dodo and Dodge - enter, and are surprised to see Santa looking at the list, clearly very agitated.

Doodle: Hello, Santa! What's the matter?

Santa: (Shocked) Don't you know what the date is...?!

Dipsy: (Matter-of-factly) It's the 24th.

Santa: Yes - Christmas Eve! (Checking his list of "Things to do")

Fetch me my Christmas suit!

Dazzle: (Trying to reassure Santa) But, Santa -

Santa: (Interrupting) Finish the presents!

Dazzle: But, Santa -

Santa: (Interrupting) Get the reindeer ready!

All the Elves: BUT, SANTA!

Santa: (Interrupting) It's going to be a VERY busy day!

☐ Track 5: BUSY, BUSY DAY

Verse 1 It's looking like a busy day,

Wipe brow, tiredly.

☐ Track 6: ON OFF MUSIC

Santa exits in a rush, keen to get started. The Elves look at each other in amazement, and shrug resignedly. They exit the opposite way to Santa.

SCENE 4: THE LAUNDRY ROOM

A busy scene, as the **Laundry Elves** enter, carrying piles of freshly washed clothes.

Narrator 5: In the laundry, the Elves are busy, washing clothes.

Suddenly, Doodle rushes on stage in a panic.

Doodle: Santa wants his Christmas suit!

Laundry Elf 1: (Confused) But -

Doodle: Santa wants his Christmas suit NOW!

Laundry Elf 1 shrugs resignedly and goes to get Santa's Christmas suit, but returns looking horrified:

Laundry Elf 1: (Shocked) It's shrunk in the wash!

Laundry Elf 1 holds up a teeny-weeny, shrunken Santa suit. Everyone freezes and takes a sharp intake of breath in horror.

Laundry Elf 2: Let's make him a new one!

J Track 7: ON OFF MUSIC

Everyone rushes off stage in a panic.

SCENE 5: THE TOY WORKSHOP

A busy scene, as the **Workshop Elves** enter, carrying a variety of different toys.

Narrator 6: The Elves are making lots of toys, ready for the girls and boys.

Track 8: WORKSHOP ELVES
