# SCENE 1: WELCOME TO OUR SHOW!

## J Track 1: MEDLEY (OPTIONAL)

Time to get ready for the start of the show! The instrumental Medley welcomes the audience as the cast assemble, ready to begin the performance...

#### SCENE 2: OUTSIDE IN THE SNOW

The stage is bare except for a colourful Christmas tree sitting to one side. Underneath the tree are several brightly-wrapped presents.

Narro	tor 1:	This is the story of a magic tree
Narrator 2:		A tree that taught us about Christmas
		<b>en (Jed</b> , <b>Pogo</b> , <b>Scoot</b> and <b>Ziggy</b> ) run on stage excitedly, from e side to where the tree is standing.
Jed:		(To Pogo, Scoot and Ziggy) We'll be late for lunch!
Kat:		(Rubbing tummy hungrily) And I'm <u>STARVING</u> !
	<b>Pogo</b> sudder	nly notices the tree on the other side of the stage, and stops.
Pogo:		(Pointing to the tree) Wow! A Christmas tree!
		Children (Kat, Chip, Buddy and Doodle) run on stage excitedly,

and everyone crowds round the tree, jostling to take a look. Suddenly, *Elves* appear beside the tree.

Elf 1: It's a <u>MAGICAL</u> Christmas tree!

Elf 2 points to the presents under the tree.

Elf 2: Those are <u>YOUR</u> presents!

All the Children: (Delighted) Yippee!

## J Track 2: THE MAGICAL CHRISTMAS TREE

The *Children* peer curiously at the presents piled under the tree.

Ziggy: Let's open the presents!

It's a mystery!

**Doodle** rummages under the tree to find the right present, excitedly tears off the paper, and holds up a book called "THE STORY OF CHRISTMAS".

**Doodle:** (Reading from the cover of the book, intrigued) The Story Of Christmas...

Everyone: (Impressed) Ooooo!

**Doodle** opens the book and reads from it:

**Doodle:** Open the presents under the tree to find out about Christmas.

The **Elves** exit, giggling. The **Children** turn to each other and shrug, confused by what's happening. **Buddy** rummages under the tree to find the right present, excitedly tears off the wrapping paper, and holds up a map.

Buddy:(Disappointed) A map?!Everyone:(Confused) What's THAT got to do with Christmas?!

#### SCENE 3: ON THE ROAD TO BETHLEHEM

Jed, Pogo, Scoot, Ziggy, Kat, Chip, Buddy and Doodle look surprised as Mary and Joseph suddenly appear on the stage. Joseph crosses to the Children and takes the map from Buddy.

Joseph:	I've been looking <u>EVERYWHERE</u> for that!
Doodle:	Who are <u>YOU</u> ?!
Mary:	I'm Mary
Joseph:	And I'm Joseph
Mary:	We need the map to get to Bethlehem.
Scoot:	How will you get there?
Everyone:	Look under the tree!

**Scoot** crosses to the Christmas tree, rummages under the tree to find the right present, excitedly tears off the wrapping paper, and holds up a bunch of hay.

Everyone: (Confused) What's THAT got to do with Christmas?!

Mary: It's hay for our donkey's dinner.

Suddenly, the **Donkey** pops into view and waves excitedly at the audience.

**Donkey:** (Hungrily) Did someone say <u>DINNER</u>?!

The **Donkey** crosses to **Scoot** and takes the hay.

- Donkey: (Rubbing tummy and licking lips appreciatively) Mmmmm, <u>THAT</u> looks tasty!
- Narrator 3: It's time to set off on their way, To Bethlehem, so far away...

# J Track 3: I'M A LITTLE DONKEY

## J Track 4: ON OFF MUSIC

Mary, Joseph and the Donkey exit.

On each "Ee-or!" hold hands up to head as imaginary ears, and flop them forward then back again!

## SCENE 4: NO ROOM AT THE INN

Jed and Kat cross to the Christmas tree.

Kat:	What happens next?	
Everyone:	Look under the tree!	
Jed:	(Concerned) We'll be late for lunch	
Kat:	(Rubbing tummy hungrily) And I'm <u>STARVING</u> !	
Everyone:	(To Jed and Kat) Shhhh!	

They peer under the tree; **Kat** rummages under the tree to find the right present, excitedly tears off the wrapping paper, and holds up a sign reading "NO VACANCIES!"

**Everyone:** (Confused) What's <u>THAT</u> got to do with Christmas?!

Suddenly, Innkeeper 1 marches up and takes the sign out of Kat's hands.

Innkeeper 1: That's mine!

Surprised, the **Children** rush off stage. More **Innkeepers** enter, and all stand in a row across the stage.

Narrator 4: Mary and Joseph arrive in Bethlehem. But there's no room at the inn.

Mary, Joseph and the Donkey enter wearily.

#### Γ Track 5: KNOCK! KNOCK! KNOCK! Verse 1 Knock! Knock! Knock! Who's there? On each "Knock!" Can we have a room? pretend to knock a door. Knock! Knock! Knock! Who's there? Mary:	We'll try next door!			
Innkeeper 1:	(Horrified) Next door is the stable!
