# **Expanding the Cast List**

The number of speaking parts can easily be increased to approximately 42:

### **Narrators**

Increase the number of Narrators (to a maximum of nine) and spread the lines out accordingly.

#### **Elves**

Increase the number of speaking Elves (to a maximum of five) and spread the lines out accordingly.

## **Innkeepers**

Increase the number of speaking Innkeepers by repeating Joseph asking for a room for the night, for the Innkeepers to reply, "Sorry, we're full up. Try next door."

# **Shepherds**

Increase the number of speaking Shepherds (to a maximum of four) and spread the lines out accordingly.

## **Angels**

Increase the number of speaking Angels (to a maximum of four) and spread the lines out accordingly.

# **Reducing the Cast List**

The number of speaking parts can easily be reduced to approximately 22; simply combine any of the following parts and spread the lines out accordingly:

- Narrators
- Children
- Elves
- Innkeepers
- Shepherds
- Angels

Several lines in the script are not essential to the story and can simply be cut.
