


### for Events Rent the Clubhouse

If you would like to become a Beautification Gardener, please contact Tom. There are no meetings to attend, no reports to be submitted, and lots of satisfaction. And, he will always available when needed.

#### TASKS INCLUDE

- Removing dead flower blossoms
- Pulling weeds from shrubbery and flower beds
- Occasionally pruning a "wild" shrubbery shoot
- Removing dead limbs and other trash/debris
- Perform "minor" pruning as needed
- Monitoring the irrigation system and reporting any malfunction
- Report deficiencies to the on-site director, Donnie Radcliffe
