Our pools are opening this month!

THE CLUBHOUSE POOL

The *Clubhouse Pool* is located at the Clubhouse, where the swim team has their meets.

This pool will be an attendant-only pool. It will be closed on all Mondays, except for Labor Day & Memorial Day.

THE SPORTS POOL

The Sports Pool is located at Oak Park (pickle-ball courts, playground); it has a slide and waterfall section for children.

Pool Passes (Fobs)

Pool Fobs are available at the Clubhouse Mondays, Tuesdays, and Wednesdays from 11a - 4p or Fridays from 9a - 2p. Guards do not have any passes at the pools.

Fobs are required to open the gates at both pools as well as our Tennis courts.

PRICING

Pool Fobs are \$30e

Cash or Check only

Reminder – Make sure your HOA dues are paid to keep your passes active. Passes are not included in your dues; if the owners of your home did not leave fobs, unfortunately you'll need to purchase replacements.

Guest Passes

Guards do not have passes at the pools. They are required to be purchased in advance!

PRICING

Guest passes are \$20 for a 10-visit card (\$2/visit/person)

Quick Reminders

LIFEGUARDS

Keep in mind that the *Clubhouse Pool* is an attendant only pool; which means that attendants are there to monitor the facility itself and are not responsible for activity in the water.

The Sports Pool has lifeguards and will conduct hourly "safety breaks" (formerly known as "Adult Swim"). Persons 18+ years and parents with infants 3y or younger may stay in the pool during this time. This is the perfect time to rehydrate, apply more sunscreen, and rest.
