





**Assembly guide** 



# Your trike comes packed into 2 separate boxes:






Box 1: Main frame and front wheel



Box 2: Rear basket, rear frame section, rear wheel, fenders, seat and accessories





## BULL





A-Remove the protective cap and ring from the steering tube

#### STEP 1: Assemble the stem and handlebar.







B-Insert the stem into the tube. Use the spacer ring (arrow) to increase the handlebar height, for lower handlebar position you can remove the spacer

ring.

C-Align the stem/handlebar in a straight position and tighten


D-Secure the handlebar tightening the top screw with an allen wrench





#### STEP 2: Connect the front and rear frame sections

Use the 6 socket head bolts and safety nuts to connect both sections but do not tighten yet, you will need to adjust the chain before fully tightening

## STEP 3: Install the front wheel



1-Remove the shipping axle from the front fork and dispose it.



2-Make sure to have the spacer washers (a) on both sides between the fork





#### STEP 3: Install the front wheel







3-Insert the front tire into the fork, the disc needs to slide into the brake caliper.


4-Connect the motor cable on the right side of the fork.



#### STEP 4: Install the chain







1-Pull down the derailleur



2-Start loading one end of the chain from top to bottom around the first small sprocket (blue arrow)... then around the second small sprocket (green arrow) and finally onto the third small sprocket (red arrow)...

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
#### STEP 4: Install the chain



3-Keep reeling out the chain towards the front. The chain should now be routed around all the gears.



4-Make sure the chain also wraps around the main sprocket.




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


#### STEP 4: Install the chain





3-Link the chain together, insert the pin lock and secure using the chain breaker (included)



4-Using a wrench # 17, tighten the 6 bolts that connect the front and rear frame sections.




#### STEP 5: Shifter cable









1-Follow the route for the shifter cable to connect it to the derailleur.

2-Insert the bare metal wire into the guide on the shifter

3-The wire will come to a stop once the rubber jacket hits the guide, tighten the security nut with a #9 wrench.



#### **STEP 6: Brakes**









1-Fix the calipers to the frame. Use the black socket head bolts, 2 bolts per side.



2-Adjust the alignment, use the top screws on both ends of the caliper to adjust, make sure the wheel spins freely

without rubbing the disc or rubbing the caliper.



### STEP 7: Front fender and headlight





Attach the bracket to the front fender







1-Install together the front fender and headlamp onto the front fork hole

2-Secure both with the socket long head bolt

3-Plug the end of the headlight cable to the other end from the trike.



#### STEP 8: Rear fenders and basket\*\*



It is highly recommended to attach the rear fenders to the rear basket before fixing the basket to the frame.




2-Fix the rear fender brackets to the rear basket

<sup>\*\*</sup>The rear basket does NOT include the wooden bottom, it can be purchased separately



#### STEP 8: Rear fenders and basket









1-Fix the rear basket with fenders to the frame using the long bolts with washers




2-Secure from underneath with the safety nuts

<sup>\*\*</sup>The rear basket does NOT include the wooden bottom, it can be purchased separately



## STEP 9: Rear tail light







1-Attach the tail light the rear end of the trike


2-Connect the trail light cable to the trike


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


## **STEP 10: Battery installation**









1-Slide the battery into its rail under the basket

2-Push the battery all the way in until it clicks into position 3-Connect the plugs of the battery rails to the main harness

<sup>\*\*</sup>The rear basket does NOT include the wooden bottom, it can be purchased separately




## STEP 11: Lights ON/OFF



#### To turn your headlight on:

- 1-Turn on your electric system by pressing and holding the M button for 3 seconds
- 2-Press and hold the arrow Up button until the light comes on, you will see the light icon on the screen
- 3-To turn off the light press and hold the Up button again. The light icon will turn off from the screen.



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
Light ON indicator on the screen

<sup>\*\*</sup>The front basket and wooden bottom are sold as accessories.




#### STEP 12: Pedals









From the accessory box, identify the left and right pedals. Fix the pedals to the crank, the left pedal is tightened counter clockwise, the right pedal clockwise. Hand-tighten the pedals first, then use a wrench.
