Please read all instructions carefully before beginning this form. Failure to fill this form out correctly causes delays in obtaining transcripts for college or military acceptance or failure to obtain diplomas and scholarships.

Only courses and grades that can be verified will be on the transcript. Grades and documentation for 12th grade is not accepted after September 1 of the graduation year. Grades and documentation for grades 9-11 are not accepted after 6 months after due date.

This form is due by May 22th for grades 10-12. Grade 9 may turn in by August 1

No transcript will be issued without this high-school form.

Instructions: The following table is an example of the proper way to complete the form.

**Column 1**: This is where you designate the rigor of the course.

TP: Tech Prep CP: College Prep AP: Advanced Placement H: Honors DC: Dual Credit

\*Note: Tech Prep and College Prep carry the same weight in the student's GPA.

**Column 2**: \*Note: You must fill in the grade year and school year in the top row.

This is where you fill in the title of the course.

\*Note: Please do not write a generic title such as Math, Social Studies, etc. Be specific, i.e. Algebra, Physical

Science.

**Column 3**: This is where you fill in the final numerical grade for the year.

\*Note: We do not round. Do not put decimal grades. If you do, we base GPA off the numbers before the decimal. If

you enter a letter grade, we will use the following numerical grades: A = 95, B = 85, C = 75, D = 65.

\*Note: Everyone in SC is required to use the Uniform Grading Scale. The scale is as follows:

100 – 90 = A | 89 – 80 = B | 79 – 70 = C | 69 – 60 = D | 59 – 0 = F

**Column 4**: This is where you place the credit earned for the course.

\*Note: If you are unsure of the amount of credit, please ask the publisher. We do not transcript quarter-credits. We

only give credit if the parent gives credit.

Repeat Courses: We do not give credit for the same course if it is taken more than once and the first grade was higher than a 76. If it

is a second or third year course of the same field of study, it must be designated as such: PE II, English III, etc.

English Grammar, Composition, Literature, Vocabulary and Spelling are all inclusive in high school English for one credit.

Science: Standard science courses must include lab. Labs are not an additional credit. You do not need to add "with labs" to

the form.

Honors, Dual Credit, AP Please refer to the handbook for specific information regarding these subjects.

CLEP tests do not qualify for high school credit.

**Internet Schools and Online courses:** 

If your student receives a report card from the A Beka Academy, Alpha Omega, or Christian Liberty, their report card **is not sufficient**. We must still receive this form.

All internet courses must be fully documented with all tests printed for availability. Most online courses

must include your DAILY DOCUMENTATION SHEET unless a progress report is included with this form.

Please refer to the high school section of the handbook (starting at page 7) for details of subjects required and other information.

## **Documenting Non-Textbook Courses**

Some elective courses do not require or use textbooks. Textbooks are available, but most families opt to take a more economical approach and create their own curriculum.

To earn a full credit, you must document a **minimum** of 135 hours. To earn a half-credit, you must document a **minimum** of 70 hours. Our documentation form is found on page 4 of this document.

**PE:** Consists of physical activity and being health-conscious. Health curricula can take the place of 75 of the work/study hours leaving the remaining 60 hours to be completed in physical activity.

Home Ec: Consists of the duties of the home: cleaning, cooking, budgeting, balancing checkbooks, planning meals, shopping & preparing meals on a budget, sewing, childcare, etc.

Fine Arts: Consists of lessons, practice, and performances. These can be combined for 1 Fine Arts Unit.

Work Credits: Consists of work hours; a letter from their supervisor stating the number of hours worked and the attitude and effort of the student is needed.
