Tools Required

- Cordless drill with adjustable torque settings.
- #2 Robertson (square drive) screwdriver or screwdriver bit.


Inspect the Product


Step 1



For a bottom-positioned Inner DrawerBOX, align your Drawer Guides with the third row of holes. With the euro screws provided, screw through the Drawer Guides holes 3 and 10 into the cabinet gable.

Step 2




Pull the Drawer Guides out from the cabinet and align the Inner DrawerBOX onto each of the guides. Push back into place until you hear a "click" sound.

Helpful hint: the locking devices provide adjustments once the cabinet has been installed to even out gaps. See how to install and adjust the devices <u>here</u>.

Step 3



Your Inner DrawerBOX is now installed.

Helpful hint: when planning Inner DrawerBOX positioning, surrounding components must be taken into consideration. Items such as hinges, shelves, and other drawers can inhibit functionality.
