We use European standard ring sizes. The number refers to the inner circumference of a ring.

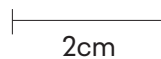
A simple way to measure your ring size is to wrap a tape measure around the finger where you want to wear the ring. The size you measure this way in millimeters is your ring size.

A better way to determine your ring size is to measure a ring with similar width that you wear comfortably. This ring sizer can help you with that.

Print

Print this guide on A4 paper making sure the printer is set to print actual size. Often the default setting in printing is „Fit to page“ – you don't want that. Make sure you print at 100% size.

When you have printed, check with a ruler that this line is 2cm long:



Measure

To measure the size of an existing ring, place the ring on the circles below. Find the circle that aligns most closely to the inner circumference of your ring.

The number inside the circle is your European ring size.

The corresponding inner diameters of your ring are given below the circle in millimeters. You can measure the inside diameter of your ring with a ruler as a control.
