So well were the slippers loved by family and friends, that Nanny's hobby soon became a small-scale production – two pairs a day!


That was the beginning of glerups

Many machines and tools were invented and trashed to keep up with
growing demand for this indoor shoe.

Today, glerups "addicts" all over the world get their daily "fix" of 100% pure, natural wool that is still crafted with love and care from the sheep to your foot.

The Headquarter

The glerups headquarter is situated in the Northern part of Denmark – on the country side with fields, trees and fresh air. The headquarter is also Nanny's home – and as glerups has grown throughout the years, it has been a part of the journey to re-build, re-decoration and expand the office facilities.

Actually today, the new warehouse building is on the field, where Nanny used to have her own Gotland sheep.

We treasure the lovely surroundings of our headquarter, and find inspiration and energy in the fresh and natural environment.





A hobby that grew

We will build a new office- and warehouse in USA 2022 and the new factory in Romania is a reality. The success continues. glerups are now sold all over the 2021 world – from Japan and Europe to New Zealand, Canada 25 years since the first pair of glerups. 2018 The color Forest is introduced – inspired by the surroundings around Nanny and Ove's home. glerups Inc. is established in the USA and a new 2015-2017 production building in Romania of 2,800 m² is on the drawing board. While widening our geographic presence, we decide 2005 to trim the collection and focus on slip-ons, shoes and boots. Nanny is now in her 60's and works with innovation and 2000 to secure that the glerups DNA is solidly integrated into the company. Nanny sees the machine "The Old Lady" and 1995 immediately recognizes the potential. "The Old Lady" will increase production capacity. 53 years old, Nanny crafts slippers for family and friends 1993 made from the natural wool of the Gotland sheep. 1985 They buy Thasdalgaard in Northern Jutland, Denmark. 1970's Nanny Glerup enrolls in a felting course where she makes a pair of boots for her husband Ove.

Our DNA

With values of quality craftsmanship and deep respect for human, nature and animal, the vision is to work in line with these values from farm to foot. This means, we continuously work towards optimizing production and inventing the right technology to limit waste.

For instance, our leather labels are made of left over leather pieces from our production and we love the idea of reducing waste and especially when it also in an elegant design upgrade.

Upcycling leftover wool into new production, give aways & POS material and cozy partnerships.

We teamed up with Lübech Living, who designed a collection of Christmas ornaments, handmade from leftover materials from the glerups production.






The Wool

It has taken many years to find the perfect recipe for our wool mix. Each year we travel to our farmers and make sure that we develop, test and innovate together.

The technical wonder of wool starts at the root of the fiber and never stops developing. It is simply amazing to work with wool.

We follow each pair of glerups from the sheep to your feet. Some farmers in New Zealand are located in areas where it is most convenient to travel by bike.





Wool is a fantastic material. Many know the benefits of wearing wool during the winter. You can wear glerups 365 days a year, and here are some good reasons for wearing wool – even in the hotter months.

Wool is naturally temperature-regulating, and can be used both when the weather offers cold and heat

Absorbs moisture and keeps your feet dry

Wool is a natural odor and bacteria inhibitor


100% pure, natural wool – good for human, nature and animal

Wool is a natural product with self-cleaning properties.

This is due to the natural fat of the wool fiber, lanolin. As the sheep get wet, a process is created between the lanolin and the sheep's natural basic salts from perspiration, which together form a natural soap that cleans the wool glerups benefit from the same characteristics.

We recommend using your slippers without socks.

Bare feet are always best for glerups!





FROM FARM TO FOOT

After the sheep are sheared, glerups wool goes through many processes and hands to ensure the highest quality and a perfect fit.

glerups started with wool from the family's own Gotland sheep. But at glerups, we never stand still!

Over the years glerups perfected the wool mix by blending Gotland wool with soft quality wool from New Zealand farmers. These farmers meet our high standards for consistent quality and humane animal welfare.

We work with our farmers every step of the way and follow each pair of glerups from the sheep to your feet.


You can clean the sole with a leather brush.






