

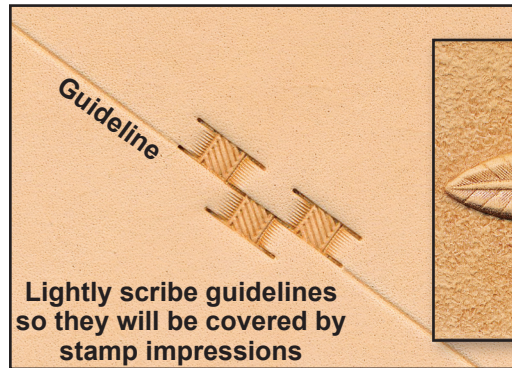
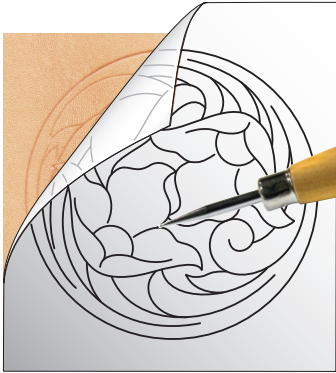


Modeling Tools

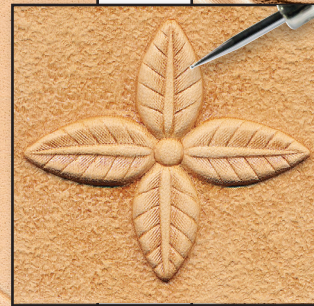
Modeling tools are handy and versatile tools that are a must for your work station. Each Realeather modeling tool has two different tips. Here are just a few of their uses.



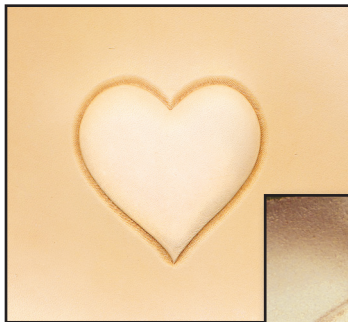
1) STYLUS END: Use the stylus to transfer patterns, scribe guidelines and to accent tooled designs.



Lightly scribe guidelines so they will be covered by stamp impressions

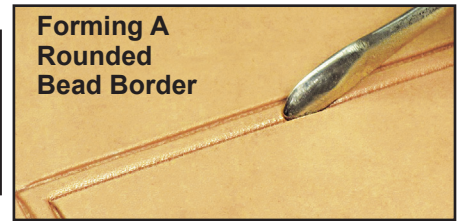
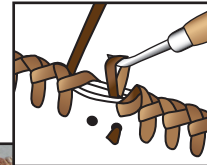
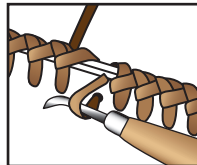


2) SPOON ENDS: Use to shape and form / mold a carved line, smooth edges, round shapes and emboss designs. Also use to help with lacing and to adjust stitches.



Embossing A Heart

Use rounded spoon to push out (emboss) on backside of tooled heart.

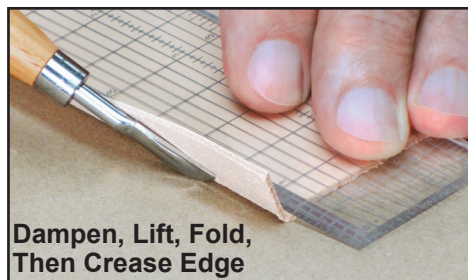


Forming A Rounded Bead Border

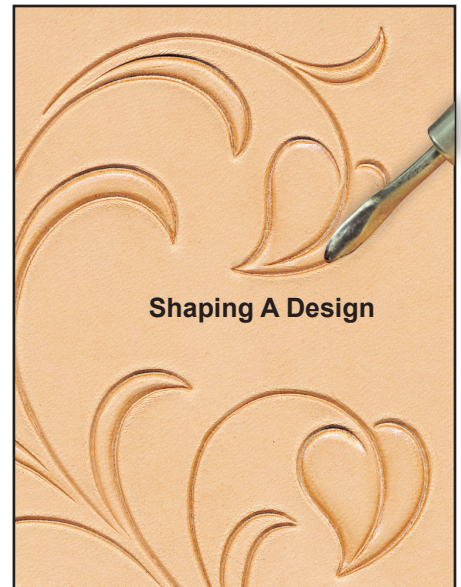
3) FLAT BLADE END: Use to open and straighten seams. Use to create, lift, fold and crease leather edges. Also use to mold and smooth.
