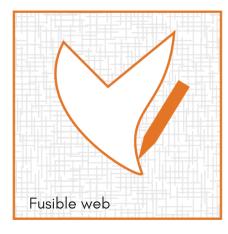
RAW EDGE APPLIQUE

with fusible web

YOU WILL NEED

- 1. Printed pattern
- 2. Your favorite fabrics
- 3. Paper backed fusible web
- 4. Thread
- 5. Embroidery stabiliser (optional)
- 1. Domestic sewing machine
- 2. Fabric and paper scissors
- 3. Iron
- 4. Pencil



Transfer the pattern

Transfer the mirror image of the applique outline to the paper lining on the fusible web.

IMPORTANT: trace the inverted (mirror) shape to get the correct final applique orientation.



2 Fuse with the fabric

Cut out roughly the traced shape from the paper backed fusible web. Place it on a back side of the fabric with the fusible web facing down. Press gently with a hot iron to fuse.



3 Stick to the background

Peel off the paper lining. Position the applique piece on the background fabric and press with a hot iron to fuse.

TIP: Use a pointy tool such as a seam ripper to handle very tiny pieces.



4 Sew the applique

Stitch slowly around the applique edges to attach. Use straight line, blanket, zigzag, satin or other decorative stitches.

TIP: Use embroidery stabiliser to avoid fabric pulling.
