



## Ring Sizing Guide

If you have a ring that fits your finger perfectly, you can place your ring over the circles on this Ring Sizing Chart to find the size that matches your ring best. You need to match the inside edge of the ring with the outside edge of the circle. If your ring is between two sizes, choose the larger size.

### When choosing a ring to take your measurement from, keep the following in mind:

- Your finger size changes, depending on the time of day and the weather. For the most accurate result, try on your ring at the end of the day and when your fingers are warm. Your fingers will be smaller in the early morning and when you're cold. If it fits comfortably, then measure the ring using our chart.
- Your ring should fit your finger comfortably, snug enough so it will not fall off, but loose enough to slide over your knuckle.
- Don't use string or paper to measure ring size, as these methods give very accurate measurements.
- If you're still unsure of your size, drop into your local jewelers and ask to have your finger measured.

### Printer settings

For the best results, PC users should go to 'printing settings' before printing and set 'page scaling' to 'none'. If you're using a Mac, hold the 'Command' button and then press 'P' to for print options. Ensure 'Scale' is selected and that it's set to '100%'. The Ring Size Chart must be printed on a full A4 size page. To check the Ring Size Chart has been printed properly, take a ruler and measure the sample below. It should measure exactly 2 cm.
