Print ready artwork & PMS colors to match


If you do not have graphic design experience (and all this information is making your head spin) we strongly encourage you to work with a graphic designer to create and finalize your artwork. Please share the information on this page. We're here to help make this process as smooth as possible, so please don't hesitate to contact us with questions.

## File Type

- Please send all artwork in an outlined vector file.
  - Acceptable formats: .ai, .eps, .pdf
  - Unacceptable formats: .jpg, .jpeg, .gif, .png
  - Please follow this link for a brief description of <u>vector v. raster files</u>

**Important:** Why vector files are important and required

- Screen printers need lines to work with. Outlined vector art files contain lines.
- Raster files contain dots not lines. Screen printers, therefore, do not have lines to work with. If your art is not outlined a screen printer cannot see anything when they open your file.



• **Internet images:** We cannot accept any files pulled from the internet. You need to own the rights to anything we print.



#### Colors:

- We require you to provide us with your choice of pantone colors to print, we are unable
  to choose colors for you because color perception is subjective. Please have the PMS
  coated colors embedded into your artwork file. Need more information? Please review

We will review your artwork before finalizing your sales order. If we find your file does not comply with the above requirements we will be unable to print it until it is revised.

# The Next Steps...

- We will review your artwork before creating and finalizing your order.
- If your file does not comply with our screen-print art requirements we will ask you to revise and re-submit it.
- If you choose to revise the file yourself, we are happy to review it up to 5 times.
- Or, we can provide a graphics person to work on your file, upon request. We do charge \$100.00 for the service.
- After the 5th review, we will request your permission to send the artwork to our graphic designer for a nominal fee of \$100.

## A few more things to take note of:

- **Black Bags:** Black bags must have a white underbase before applying other colors. Two (2) is the minimum number of colors to print on a black bag.
- White Ink: White ink requires an undercoat of a white base, if your artwork includes
  white as a primary color it will count as two (2) colors plus any additional colors in your
  design. Note: in many cases you can omit the white color and use the natural color of
  the bag as a design element.
- **Gradients:** We cannot screen-print gradients of a color (ie: going from light blue to dark blue). We can only print individual PMS colors.
- **50 99 bags:** Three (3) colors is the maximum number of colors allowable for any job of 50 99 bags.
- **100+ bags**: Six (6) is the maximum number of colors we can print for any job of 100+ bags.
- We do offer digital printing. With digital printing we can print any image you own the rights to on one of our bags. Please ask your Account Services Rep or email <u>orders@ecobags.com</u> for a digital printing quote.
