

Sprinkle a little fun on your apgligue!

## Cactus Table Runnen

Finished size: 45" x $21 \frac{112 "}{}{ }^{\prime \prime}$


## Materials: (WOF = 42")

- Four finished Confetti Cactus designs. Cut each to 8" x 11"
- A strips: 3 light fabrics: 2" x 42" (WOF) each; 3 dark fabrics: $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ each (OR 6 fat quarters)
- B and C strips: 9 assorted fabrics: $2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ each OR 9 fat quarters
- D squares: 1 fat quarter
- $11 / 2$ yards fabric for backing and $1 / 4$ yard for binding


## Instructions:

## A strips

Step 1: Cut one, 2" x WOF strip from each of the light fabrics and one, $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF from each of the dark fabrics.

Step 2: Stitch one light strip and one dark strip together along the long edge with a $1 / 4$ " seam to form a strip that is $6 " \mathrm{x}$ WOF. Repeat for other two sets.

Step 3: Subcut each of the three resulting strips into 11, 2" x 6" strips. You will need 32 of these A strips. You will have some fabric left over.

## $B$ and C strips

Step 1: Cut one, $2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ WOF strip from each 9 fabrics OR two, $2^{\prime \prime} \times 21$ " strips from each fat quarter
Step 2: For C strips, choose three of the 9 assorted fabric strips and cut one 2 " x 11 " strip from each for a total of three C strips. With the remaining strips, subcut each strip into 2" x 6 " pieces. You will need 28 of these B strips for the table runner. You may have some strips left over.

## D squares

Step 1: Cut four, 6" x 6" corner squares.

## A Strips





Cut 11 strips from each of the three sets. You need 32, 2" x 6" A strips. You will have extra fabric.

## B and C Strips

42" (Cut two, 2" x 21" strips from each of the 9 fabrics if using fat quarters)
Step 1: $2 " \square$


You will need 3,2 " $\times 11^{\prime \prime}$ C strips and 28,2 " $\times 6$ " B strips for border.

Lastly, cut 4, 6" $\times 6^{\prime \prime}$ D corner squares


1. Using the diagram below, join the $A$ and $B$ strips together using a $1 / 4 "$ seam. The top and bottom panels use 12, A strips and 11, B strips. The side panels use 4, A strips and 3, B strips.
2. Add the D corners to the top and bottom strips.
3. Join the 8 " $\times 11$ " cactus blocks with the C strips using a $1 / 4$ " seam.
4. Join the side panels to the cactus panel.
5. Add the top and bottom panels.
6. Adding batting, quilt, and bind! You can also use this as a wall hanging, but remember to put a sleeve on the back.
7. If this is a gift, be sure to add a label to the back!
