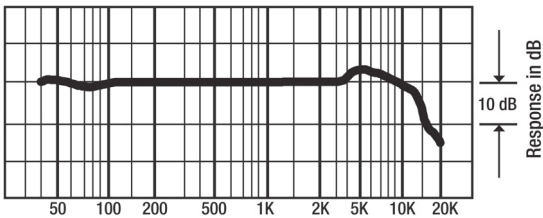

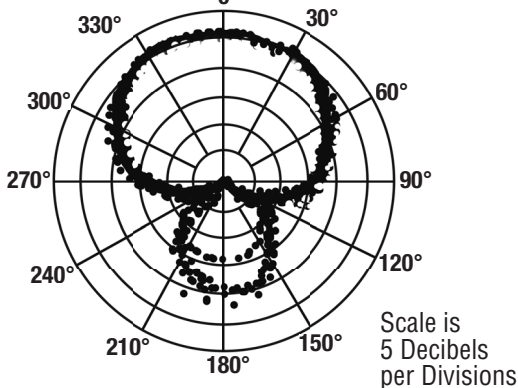
Frequency Response

LEGEND ——— 12" or more on axis

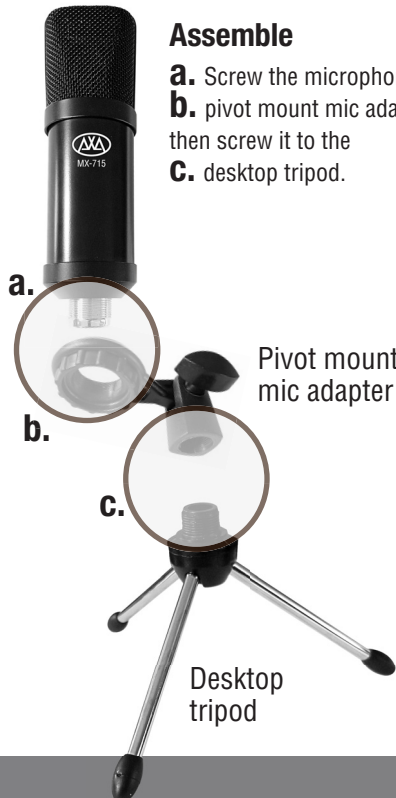
Polar Pattern

Speak or sing into the front of the mic for the best sound quality. The frontside is the AXA logo side.



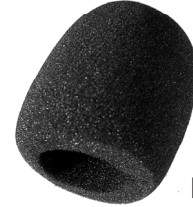
