

READ FIRST! IMPORTANT SAFTEY TIPS AND INSTRUCTIONS



- 1. Keep away from heat, sparks, and flame. Do not use as a cooking tent or sweat lodge. Materials are flammable.
- 2. Avoid setting-up in moderate or heavy winds. May result in damage to the product or cause injuries.
- **3.** For recreational use only, not as a permanent structure. Do not leave unattended in severe weather conditions.
- **4.** Handle **No See-Um Mesh** with care. Mesh is delicate so avoid sharp objects and zippers against it or excessive pulling. Watch out for abrasive surfaces i.e. rocks, pavement.*
- 5. Do not force zippers or X Brackets if met with resistance. Check and reset position.
- **6.** Shake off excess water and dirt before storing in the bag.
- 7. Clean with mild detergent.
- **8.** Store in **Carry Case** when not in use.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

- Remove products from the Carry Case.
- Until the tent in an open space. **DO NOT** remove **Fiberglass Poles** from the sockets.

Inspect the X Brackets. All X Brackets (covered in removable felt fabric pouch) should be facing the same direction.



TIP: 5 sided tent has 5 joints; 6 sided tent has 6.


SETTING UP STRUCTURAL WALLS Locate Lanyard Eyebolt Handle (opposite side of the **X Bracket**.)


> Step back as you pull on the **Lanyard Eyebolt Handle** until the attached **X Bracket** pops inward and becomes an interior wall. Repeat until all walls are opened.

Tip 1: Allow plenty of room when setting up tent walls as they expand quickly like umbrellas. Point all parts, X Brackets away from animals, children and by standers to avoid injury.

Tip 2: (NOMAD™ Model): *Tent is packed with the curtains* zippered down. Reach inside the grommet to locate the Lanyard Eyebolt Handle.

LOCATE THE ENTRANCE

Check the roof line for **AxplorOutdoor Logo** which is imprinted on the top right corner of the entrance. Once all walls are erected, adjust the tent to face a desired direction.






6 SETTING UP THE ROOF


From the inside push up the center **X Bracket**


to erect the roofline.



Visual Inspection - From inside the tent, visually inspect the X Brackets making sure all the Fiberglass Poles have expanded fully(a.) and not out the sockets(b.). Reposition the tent to ensure shape retention and equal

weight distribution.






8 SECURING THE ENTRANCE DOOR FRAME

a. Unpack the two Fiberglass Poles from their carry case.

b. Insert the **Fiberglass Poles** into the top and bottom sockets in the interior frame.





9 STAKING DOWN THE TENT (RECOMMENDED)*

Stake Loops are located at the base of each corner.

Stake down each corner of the tent for added security.


*Zip close entrance before staking down tent.







GUY LINES (OPTIONAL)


For additional stability use **Guy Lines**. Tie one side to **Lanyard Eyebolt Handle**, and **Stake** down the other side.




- **11** ATTACH THE FLOOR (SUMMERLIN™ / NOMAD™ MODELS ONLY)
 - a. Unfold the Bathtub Style Tarp Floor, Barrel Toggles and Floor Hooks should be facing outward.
 - **b.** Attach Barrel Toggle to Corner Tent Loop.
 - c. From the outside pull Floor Hook under the Tent and hook it to the Stake.









- **ENTRANCE AND WALL ZIPPER PANELS (NOMAD™** Model only)
 - a. Roll up and keep it up.
- **b.** Zippers on both sides.
- c. Hide the zipper with velcro attachment.







DISASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

- Remove all items from inside the **Tent** and shake off any debris and water from the roof . Remove **Stakes** and **Guy Lines** from the ground.
- 2 Zip down wind panels and pack away **Bathtub Tarp Floor**. (**SUMMERLIN™** and **NOMAD™** Models)
- 3 REMOVE TWO Fiberglass Poles from the interior right / left door frame. Refold and return to its carry bag.
- **DO NOT REMOVE ANY OTHER POLES** from the sockets as you pack down the tent.
- From the inside, pull down the roof top **X Bracket** slowly to lower the roof line.
- **6** From the outside, push in **X Bracket** one wall at a time.
- 7 Fold down the **Tent** with all **X Brackets** facing the same direction.
- Return **Tent** and accessories to the **Carry Case**.

WARRANTY
