## FIND YOUR RING SIZE

To use this guide, ensure you are printing on US letter sized paper ( $8.5 \mathrm{x} \mathrm{x} 1 \mathrm{l}^{\prime \prime}$ ) and it is scaled to $100 \%$.
After printing, use a ruler to verify that your ruler measurement and the printed measurement at the bottom of this page are the same.
METHOD I: Measure your finger to find your size
a. Cut out the ring sizer tape and cut a slit where indicated. With the numbers facing out, slide the end through the slit and pull the end so that it fits snuggly around your finger and can slide over your knuckle comfortably.
b.lf you are between two sizes, order the next size up. Please note that rings with wider bands tend to fit more snuggly than thinner ring bands. If ordering a ring with a very wide or tall band, we recommend ordering the next size up.


METHOD 2: Measure a ring you already own to find your size
a. Select a ring that fits you comfortably on the desired finger
b. Place the ring over the circles below until you find one that lines up with the inside edge of your ring.
c. If the ring falls between two sizes, order the next size up.


Measure the bar below with a ruler
and ensure it is exact
