As with the Debut turntable models and their Essential and Primary descendants, the tonearm is 8.6in long and made from aluminium and employs sapphire bearings for smooth travel. Where it

differs from many other examples is that Pro-Ject has optimised it to work with the Ortofon OM series movingmagnet cartridge. This means that there's no anti-skate adjustment.

For those that are on a tight budget, the Primary E is a serious starter deck and a bit of a bargain at the price.

Conclusion

What is most surprising about the Primary E, is its ability to deliver a genuinely satisfying musical performance at such a very attractive price and make it an ideal turntable for any new or returning fans to the format.

It keeps poorer pressings listenable in a way that rivals often struggle to.
