Kenya offers a fascinating mixture of adventure, excellent wildlife, and authentic Masai culture. From the rocky foothills of Mount Kenya to the dry plains of Samburu, this magnificent country has an incredible diversity of experiences which can be enjoyed on horseback, camel back, on foot, or in a safari vehicle. In this sense, it is a great destination for families and active travellers looking for unique ways of experiencing the wilderness. At the end of a busy safari, Lamu is a peaceful coastal haven with an intriguing history. We choose lodges that have an authentic feel and make you feel as if you are staying at a home away from home.

Day 1

On arrival at Nairobi International Airport, a private driver will collect you and take you to the border of Nairobi National Park, where you stay for the night at Ole Sereni Lodge. Dinner and overnight at Ole Sereni.



Ole Sereni is a good quality lodge ideally located for your first night stay in Nairobi. Observe wildlife meandering past on the bordering national park while enjoying sundowner drinks from the mezzanine restaurant.

Day 2 & 3

After breakfast, you will be transferred to Wilson Airport in time for your flight to Lewa Conservancy. Lewa is home to several endangered species including the rhino and the 'Northern Five,' which are species unique to the area. If you crave adventure, you can go camel riding, walk to a waterfall, do a walking safari, or take a helicopter flip in addition to game driving. Stay at Elewana Kifaru Lodge.



Elewana Kifaru Lodge is a haven of luxury in the bush, where guests immediately feel at home, warmly welcomed by the friendly and attentive staff. The comfortable sitting room with wellstocked bar and elegant dining area extend out to a large, comfortably furnished terrace. Here, guests can enjoy a sunny breakfast al fresco and watch the busy goings-on at the waterhole below, or they can choose to relax by the picturesque infinity pool and enjoy the magnificent views over the distant plains. The property luxuriates in total exclusivity with five charming thatched cottages tucked away in an oasis of vibrant lawns, filled with birdsong. All have well-appointed bedrooms, with sumptuous four-poster beds and generous en-suite bathrooms.

With an excellent library and log fires in the lounge and dining rooms, guests can truly sink into delicious, cosy comfort during the cool evenings, and luxuriate in the peace and serenity of the African night.

Day 4, 5 & 6

Enjoy a relaxed morning, then take a game drive and transfer to Lewa Airstrip for your flight to the Masai Mara where you stay in the less crowded Naboisho Conservancy along an unfenced border with the national park, allowing a quieter experience of wildlife. In shoulder season, you will enjoy a large variety of diverse wildlife species, and this area is particularly well known for its excellent Big Cat populations. For the next three days, choose between full day game drives with a picnic lunch in the park, or two half day game drives with relaxation and lunch at camp. Stay at Encounter Mara Camp.



Encounter Mara is situated under the acacia trees in a wildlife-rich area of the Masai Mara. From the camp's outdoor viewing deck, guests can watch zebras amble to the nearby saltlick, see a giraffe strut right past camp, glimpse a mongoose running down the path right in front of you or even spot a cheetah prowling the plains. Over sundowners around the campfire, listen for lions calling to each other as they start their night of hunting. From Encounter Mara, guests can go on nature walks around camp, or soar across the plains in a hot-air balloon.

Day 7

Enjoy one last early game drive and breakfast in the Mara. After breakfast, a guide from Encounter Mara will take you on a game drive/transfer to Mara Airstrip in time for your flight to Nairobi. You are booked in a day room at Ole Sereni so you can have a shower and rest in comfort before your flight back home.
