



Tanzania is an ideal destination for the first-time safari traveller. The Serengeti provides a vast background to the Great Migration, where wildebeest gather in huge herds, moving north to south in search of greener pastures and attracting a host of predators along the way. Tarangire offers a unique landscape, and Ngorongoro crater promises diverse ecosystems and a host of amazing resident wildlife.

This exclusive itinerary uses an easy pace to allow you to fully engage with the wildlife yet enjoy the full spectrum of diverse landscapes in Tanzania.

Day 1

On arrival at Kilimanjaro Airport, a private driver will collect you and take you in a Landcruiser to the charming Onsea House boutique hotel in a leafy suburb of Arusha. Dinner at <u>Onsea House</u> and rest for the evening.

Onsea House epitomizes charming comfort in a picturesque setting, which is unique in Arusha. With more personal approach than in a hotel and more privacy than a lodge resort, the lodge offers a warm welcoming atmosphere combined with excellent food and wonderful views over Arusha.



Day 2

After breakfast, your guide collects you for your first game drive in Tarangire NP. In dry season, huge herds of elephant pass through the park and lions roam along the semi-arid riverbeds dotted with unusual Baobob trees. You will do a full day game drive, with picnic lunch in the park. Overnight at <u>Maramboi Tented Lodge</u>.



Maramboi Tented Lodge offers Zebras, giraffes, warthogs, gazelles right at the doorstep. Wildlife is visible between the palm trees from the terrace of your exclusive tent, from the swimming pool whilst enjoying a cool drink after a walk with a Maasai guide or whilst you enjoy a delicious dinner under the stars.

The elegant tents are built on raised wood platforms with a private terrace and views of Lake Manyara and the Rift Valley. Each room has a bathroom with shower and is nicely appointed in crisp white linens and breezy colors.



Day 3

Early this morning, your private driver takes you on a lush ascent towards the Ngorongoro Crater rim, where you stop to take in the incredible views. Enjoy a full day game driving in the diverse landscape on the crater floor, where you will see most of the Big 5. Stay overnight near the crater rim on a coffee plantation at <u>Plantation Lodge</u>.

Like a green oasis, **The Plantation Lodge** rests on a hillside overlooking a lush coffee plantation. The individually furnished rooms offer a serene feel in a garden setting. This owner-run lodge has a personal atmosphere, with furnishings that were selected with great attention to detail. The Plantation Lodge's cordial service leaves no wish unfulfilled. The lodge's location promises maximum safari enjoyment: a stone's throw from the entrance to the Ngorongoro Conservation Area.



Day 4, 5, & 6

Today, you will fly into the Serengeti on a small caravan. On arrival at the small airstrip, a driver from your camp will meet you and take you on your first game drive en route to <u>Ubuntu Migration Camp</u>. The wildlife in the Serengeti is very diverse, roaming amidst Acacia trees on the open savannah – the typical African scene you would imagine. Settle in for lunch at camp after your drive, then head out for another afternoon game drive. Over the next three days, you can enjoy game drives and activities from the camp, witnessing the great migration or general resident wildlife in proximity to camp.

Ubuntu Migration Camp follows the colossal herds of wildebeest as they journey around the Serengeti. From the dramatic river crossings in the north to the fertile grasslands in the south where the wildebeest give birth, we set up camp nearby to ensure you're always close to the action.



This traditional tented camp is designed to leave no trace. It moves with the Great Migration herds to new pastures. Every day, we're out in the bush looking for wildlife such as lions or cheetahs attracted by the huge gatherings of prey. Each tent has hot showers and flushing toilets, with plush cosy furniture for the ultimate luxury safari experience.

Day 7

Today is your last day in the wild. Enjoy breakfast at camp, then do a game drive/transfer through the Serengeti to the airstrip. Your caravan flight will take you back to Kilimanjaro Airport where you will catch your flight home.

Or enquire about the optional add on for a few days at the beach in **Zanzibar**.
